GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

6th Sunday of Easter

Jesus tells his disciples, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you.” The peace that Jesus gives is far different than the kind that comes from the absence of war, conflict, or affliction. The peace that God offers is found alongside suffering and hardship, not necessarily in their absence. St. Teresa of Avila offers us a bit of wisdom regarding peace: “May today there be peace within. May you trust God that you are exactly where you are meant to be. May you not forget the infinite possibilities that are born of faith. May you use those gifts that you have received and pass on the love that has been given to you. May you be content knowing you are a child of God. Let this presence settle into your bones and allow your soul the freedom to sing, dance, praise, and love. It is there for each and every one of us.”

In order for us to experience the divine peace that Jesus offers, we have to allow God’s presence to settle into our bones! It is only when this happens that we can be truly taught by the Holy Spirit to discern the true path to peace and find ourselves with untroubled hearts. The world and our lives are so unpredictable and changeable. If we look for a source of lasting and real peace only there, our search will never be satisfied. Something will always unsettle and disturb us. The Jewish disciples could really relate to what Jesus was saying about peace (shalom). They already knew that it was more a matter of achieving wholeness and wellbeing than anything else.

Wholeness and wellbeing are precisely what is uncovered when we begin to really see and know the height, depth, and breadth of God’s presence and promise. The elegance of God’s Divine life flows through our blood and the marrow in our bones. It is that close and deep. As we breathe in and exhale God’s life, peace becomes what we know within and what is exhaled out. This remains in the midst of intense conflict, persecution, suffering, rejection, and even death.

6º Domingo de Pascua

“Jesús promete a los Apóstoles el don del Espíritu Santo, cuya tarea será enseñar y recordar sus palabras a la comunidad de discípulos. Enseñar y recordar: esto es lo que hace el Espíritu Santo en nuestros corazones” (Papa Francisco). Es muy cierto y se tiene la experiencia, de que, la persona que se abandona al Espíritu Santo, da muchos frutos de continua enseñanza y de obras buenas que el Espíritu de Dios hace en ella. Los santos y santas lo han experimentado en sus vidas, mostrando su fe con hechos. El amor de Dios nunca se cansa, si está presente, suceden cosas maravillosas.

“El que ama verdaderamente a Dios, observa sus mandamientos y Dios entra en su corazón y ahí permanece, porque el amor de Dios llena de tal manera su corazón, que al tiempo que le da tentación, no vuelve a su vida pasada” (San Gregorio Magno (540-640) Homilía 30). El reto, en este Sexto Domingo de Pascua, es que continuemos abriendo nuestro corazón y mente a la paz y al amor del Señor. Esa paz y su amor ayudarán a sanar las heridas sufridas por falta de amor, y quitará el miedo que se arraiga en la vida de la persona, a causa, muchas veces, de la falta de Dios en su vida. “Les dejo la paz, les doy mi paz, la paz que yo les doy no es como la que da el mundo. Que no haya en ustedes angustia ni miedo” (Juan 14:27). Oh, bien. “Si alguien me ama, guardará mis palabras” (Juan 14:23). Nuestra tarea: siempre tener la esperanza de enseñar y recordar todo lo que hemos recibido de Dios a los que nos rodean.





From the desk of Fr. Frank Jindra...

I want to tell you about an apostolate that we have had at Saints Peter and Paul for several years. It began in Mexico City. It is called Mater Filius. It is a home for women in crisis pregnancies. The women who have been helped have ranged from boyfriend abused victims brought to Mater Filius by her parents, to women addicted to drugs, to women who felt they had no other way out but did not want to abort their baby. Mater Filius supports these women through the time of delivery and offers them ongoing housing for the next nine months. And more support after that. They follow the mother and child for years if that is what the mother wants.

But the program at Mater Filius does not stop there. The program expects these women to take a serious look at their own spiritual lives, even if they are not Catholic, as they come to some new sense of who they are as daughters of God. The program expects them to grow into women who can care for their children. There have been some marvelous success stories. There have also been some women who have stayed for a mere few hours.

One of the success stories I love to talk about is a young lady who is now a nurse and caring for her new family. When she came to Mater Filius, she had not even finished high school. But now, by the grace of God, she has a career, and she is very happy.

But Mater Filius is not just here in Omaha. As I said it started in Mexico City and is truly an international organization. There are multiple cities in the United States that have this program. But Omaha is the first! What a glorious gift Mater Filius has been and will continue to be to the body of Christ. It has the full support of Archbishop Lucas, Father Bond, and Father Jindra.

Quiero hablarles de un apostolado que hemos tenido en los Santos Pedro y Pablo durante varios años. Comenzó en la Ciudad de México. Se llama Mater Filius. Es un hogar para mujeres en embarazos en crisis. Las mujeres que han sido ayudadas han variado desde víctimas de abuso de novio traídas a Mater Filius por sus padres, hasta mujeres adictas a las drogas, hasta mujeres que sentían que no tenían otra salida pero no querían abortar a su bebé. Mater Filius apoya a estas mujeres durante el momento del parto y les ofrece vivienda continua durante los próximos nueve meses. Y más apoyo después de eso. Siguen a la madre y al niño durante años si eso es lo que la madre quiere.

Pero el programa en Mater Filius no se detiene ahí. El programa espera que estas mujeres tomen una mirada seria a sus propias vidas espirituales, incluso si no son católicas, a medida que llegan a un nuevo sentido de quiénes son como hijas de Dios. El programa espera que se conviertan en mujeres que puedan cuidar a sus hijos. Ha habido algunas historias de éxito maravillosas. También ha habido algunas mujeres que se han quedado apenas unas horas.

Una de las historias de éxito de las que me encanta hablar es de una joven que ahora es enfermera y cuida a su nueva familia. Cuando llegó a Mater Filius, ni siquiera había terminado la escuela secundaria. Pero ahora, por la gracia de Dios, ella tiene una carrera, y está muy feliz. Pero Mater Filius no solo está aquí en Omaha. Como dije, comenzó en la Ciudad de México y es verdaderamente una organización internacional. Hay varias ciudades en los Estados Unidos que tienen este programa.

¡Pero Omaha es el primero! Qué glorioso regalo ha sido y seguirá siendo Mater Filius para el cuerpo de Cristo. Cuenta con el apoyo total del Arzobispo Lucas, el Padre Bond y el Padre Jindra.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Management According to the Apostles

If you've ever worked in any kind of organization, for-profit or not-for-profit, I'm sure you have attended a conference or two. Whatever our expectations going in, I usually find these conferences expose me to communication and problem-solving styles that are different from my own, nudging me into a little unexpected self-discovery. And it's a great opportunity to meet new people and do something different.

Here's my idea for a leadership conference: The Management Style of the Apostles. Think about it, the only thing the Apostles had more abundantly than holiness was problems. Lots and lots of problems ... most of them of the human resources variety. It's no small feat, starting Christ's Church on earth. I wouldn't want to be project manager of that endeavor.

The Acts of the Apostles is, in some ways, a big book full of problems and ways to solve them. It's a blueprint for tackling interpersonal issues in the manner of a true steward, who encounters every problem starting from the same place: What would my Master want?

It's a question we should be asking ourselves every time we, too, encounter a problem – especially problems relating to other people. What is the truth in this situation, and how would God have me communicate it? How could I handle this in a way that is worthy of the name of my Master?

In Acts, we see a lot of characteristics of everyday stewardship. We see the Apostles mindfully acknowledge the lack of peace that is posed by problems like false teachings, this Gospel's problem du jour. They prayerfully confront the obstacles to salvation posed by these issues. Always, always, always, their main objective is to reveal the will of God, remaining committed to the truth while helping newcomers find avenues to salvation.

Maybe I'm just saying it because it's my idea – but it sounds like a conference we could all use.

LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD DIARIA: RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

Administración según los apóstoles

Si alguna vez has trabajado en cualquier tipo de organización, con o sin fines de lucro, estoy seguro de que has asistido a una conferencia o dos. Cualquiera que sean nuestras expectativas, por lo general encuentro que estas conferencias me exponen a estilos de comunicación y resolución de problemas que son diferentes a los míos, empujándome a un poco de autodescubrimiento inesperado. Y es una gran oportunidad para conocer gente nueva y hacer algo diferente.

Esta es mi idea para una conferencia de liderazgo: El estilo de administración de los apóstoles. Piénsalo, lo único que los Apóstoles tenían más abundantemente que la santidad eran los problemas. Muchos, muchos problemas...la mayoría de ellos de la variedad de recursos humanos. No es poca cosa, comenzar la Iglesia de Cristo en la tierra. No quisiera ser gerente de proyecto de ese esfuerzo.

Los Hechos de los Apóstoles es, en cierto modo, un gran libro lleno de problemas y formas de resolverlos. Es un plan para abordar los problemas interpersonales a la manera de un verdadero corresponsable, que se encuentra con todos los problemas comenzando desde el mismo lugar: ¿Qué querría mi Maestro?

Es una pregunta que deberíamos hacernos cada vez que también nos encontramos con un problema, especialmente problemas relacionados con otras personas. ¿Cuál es la verdad en esta situación y cómo quiere Dios que la comunique? ¿Cómo podría manejar esto de una manera que sea digna del nombre de mi Maestro?

En Hechos, vemos muchas características de la corresponsabilidad diaria. 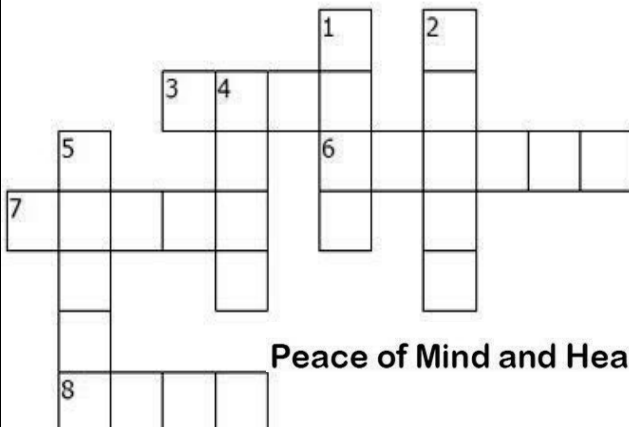
