We will offer a Blessing of Throats following Mass the weekend of **February 3rd & 4th**, in honor of St. Blaise, whose feast day is February 3rd.

According to the centuries-old tradition, two candles are blessed, held slightly open, and

pressed against the throat as the blessing is said: "Oh God, deliver us through the intercession of Thy holy bishop and martyr, Blaise, from all evil of soul and body, especially from all ills of the throat." Saint Blaise is the patron of physicians, sick cattle, wax-chandlers, wool combers, and of wild animals because of his care for them and of those with throat maladies. He was a bishop of Sebastea in Armenia who was martyred during a Christian persecution in the fourth century.


