From the Pastor's Desk First Fucharist

On Saturday, May 11th, thirteen of our children received their first Holy Communion. They received Jesus Christ our Savior for the first time. But the special congratulation goes to all who made their First Communion. I hope you will always treasure this beautiful gift that Jesus gave you, and that through time you will realize that you are to become more and more like Jesus every day.
