



Happy Catechetical Sunday everyone! Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Our Catechists will be at the 8AM Mass and will receive a special blessing. There is a free Virtual Eucharistic Revival Conference on September 22-24 sponsored by the USCCB called, "Becoming Eucharistic People." Register at bit.ly/erc22. The Catholic Church has entered a three-year Eucharistic Revival! Come and discover what that means for you! Also, in response to the diocesan year of Eucharistic Revival, SS. Cosmas and Damian Parish in Twinsburg will be hosting the Eucharistic Miracle Display as chronicled by Blessed Carlo Acutis. Blessed Carlo was a teenager from Italy who developed a website dedicated to the documented and scientifically scrutinized occasions when the Holy **Eucharist changed in its physical appearance, reminding** us that the bread and wine of the Mass truly become the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. From October 17-30, 2022, SS. Cosmas and Damian Parish will be welcoming tours from Catholic schools and parishes, as well as the local and surrounding cities. The event is completely free. The parish campus will be set up like a museum for the thousands that are expected to participate in the event. New Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Cleveland, Most Reverend Michael Woost, will be offering Mass on Saturday, October 22 at 4:00pm. Our Pet Blessing is Tuesday, October 4th at 6:30PM. The blessing will be held in the parking lot near the church entrance and it will be led by Deacon Carl. Coast to Coast Rosary is Sunday, October 9th at 4PM. Please arrive by 3:45PM so we can begin promptly at 4PM. Weather permitting, the recitation of the Rosary will take place in front of the fire pit. If it is rainy, we pray the Rosary in the Church. The Diocese of Cleveland is offering a day of enrichment for Married Couples called, "Strategies for Strengthening Relationships" at Saint Basil The Great Parish on October 23rd. The marriage enrichment event will include, an interactive presentation where couples learn and practice ways to enhance trust, understanding, intimacy, and selfawareness as they build connection with their spouse. Mass starts at 9 AM followed by a continental breakfast and the program based on the Gottman method. The presenter will be licensed clinical counselor; Nicole Melchi from Kent Psychological Associates. Registration deadline is October 17th. Registration is \$20. Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Mary Lou Beers at MBeers@smmwillowick.org or (440) 725-3198.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
