



From Fr. Steve...

Congrats to Sean Dille and James Franey our newest members of Parish Council. I look forward to their input. Thanks to all who applied. I did receive several impressive applications. From the remaining applications, I will bring two more parishioners into Parish Council in the Spring of 2023. You will notice we have a new ceiling fan. It's quiet and it is effective! We have another ceiling fan on the way. Once all the fans are replaced, I think everyone will feel the difference! You may have heard we are moving forward with a parish festival for next year. Jim Arndt, Rosemarie Sisler and I met with the city and received approval. Recently, all our parish festival sub committees had a meeting to discuss next year's festival. With our festival there will be some noticeable changes. We will not be having any rides or concessions from Bates Amusements. Also, we will be adjusting our festival hours. Our Fire Department is working with University Hospital to provide a staffed Medical Tent and that will be a nice addition. With the removal of rides, we will use some of the space for handicap parking and add other family friendly activities. We will be working closely with the city with the layout of our festival. Willowick Police Officer Keith Lawrence is also looking at ways to take security to another level to keep everyone safe. The removal of rides brings a considerable loss of income. If the weather is nice during the festival, the rides would bring in around \$20,000.00 for the parish. Plus, Bates would bring in its own workers. So, as we look to replace the rides, we might take a loss in income, and we will need more help to operate the new concessions. So, I hope we can pull together to fill these spots. As many spoke to me about our festival over the summer, many lamented the loss of the festival on East 185th and the one at Lake Shore Shopping Center. So, I hope this brings some excitement to know we will continue having a festival. There are some wonderful and successful festivals in the area that do not have rides, like Saint John Vianney and Immaculate Conception in Willoughby. So, hopefully with everyone's help and God's blessing, we can do the same with our festival. Speaking of fund raisers, our MegaRaffle will be mailed soon. In the packet is valuable information about our Advent Giving Project, Advent & Christmas Schedule and information on the Angel Scholarship Fund. With October around the corner, Our Pet Blessing is Tuesday, October 4th at 6:30PM. Coast to Coast Rosary is Sunday, October 9th at 4PM. Weather permitting, the recitation of the Rosary will take place in front of the fire pit. God bless!



SACRAMENTS **Baptism**

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith through Baptism may contact Mary Lou Beers at (440) 725-3198.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Mary Lou Beers at MBeers@smmwillowick.org or (440) 725-3198.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
