Happy October everyone! Each year, the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is observed as Respect Life Sunday. As Catholics, we are called to cherish, defend, and protect those who are most vulnerable, from the beginning to the end of their lives, and at every point in between. During the month of October, the Church asks us to reflect more deeply on the dignity of every human life. So, let us take the time to reflect on this great gift! This Tuesday, October 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM is our Pet Blessing which will be led by Deacon Carl Toomey. Thank you, Deacon Carl! Also, October 4<sup>th</sup> is the Priest Convocation. Due to the Convocation, there will be a Communion Service on October 5<sup>th</sup> at 9AM. October 9<sup>th</sup> is our Coast to Coast Rosary. 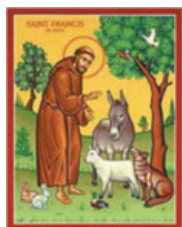

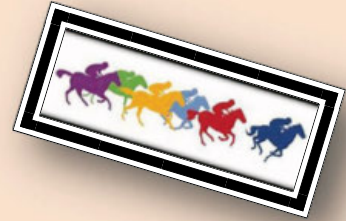

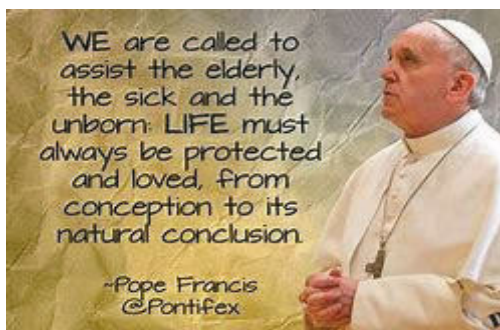

## SACRAMENTS

### Baptism

### First Communion
