



Happy October everyone! Each year, the Catholic **Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life** Month, and the first Sunday of October is observed as Respect Life Sunday. As Catholics, we are called to cherish, defend, and protect those who are most vulnerable, from the beginning to the end of their lives, and at every point in between. During the month of October, the Church asks us to reflect more deeply on the dignity of every human life. So, let us take the time to reflect on this great gift! This Tuesday, October 4th at 6:30PM is our Pet Blessing which will be led by Deacon Carl Toomey. Thank you, Deacon Carl! Also, October 4th is the Priest Convocation. Due to the Convocation, there will be a Communion Service on October 5th at 9AM. October 9th is our Coast to Coast Rosary. Weather permitting, the Rosary will begin promptly at 4PM. 

Baptism

First Communion


