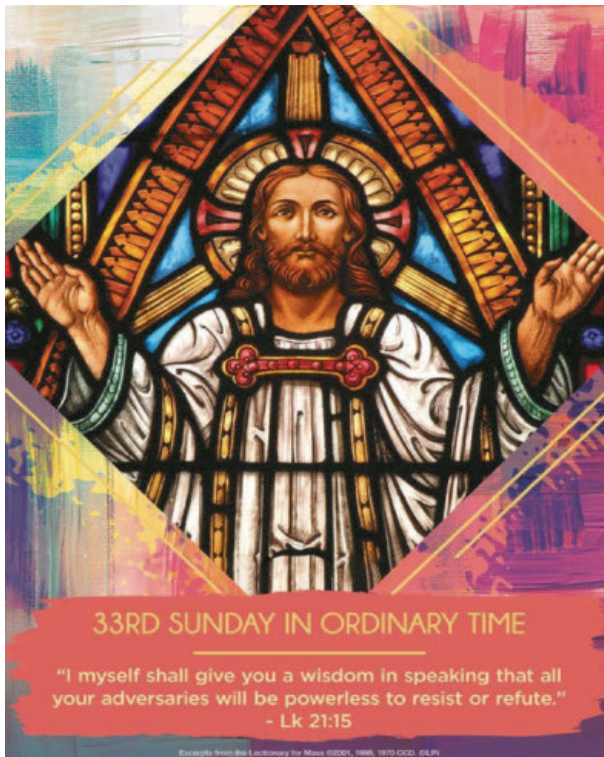

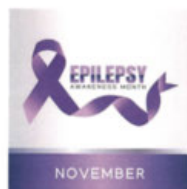

### Baptism
