Paper Pulpit

During the summer months there usually is not a lot happening in parish churches. This year that is even truer with the covid. For parish leadership, summers are a good time to reflect on ministries and parish activities for the fall. This past week I met with the Pastoral and Finance Council Chairs (Dawn Obremski, Matt Ahles, Bob Brandt and Mary Krueger). We discussed succession planning and in particular, Buildings and Grounds and Parish Secretary.

Over the years, we have looked to Carl and a few others to do most of the work. He and others have done a lot for the parish and it is greatly appreciated. But we should be spreading the work so 1) it doesn't fall on one person and 2) we have back-ups for the building & grounds care. We are in the process of putting together a group to help oversee the parish facilities so it does not fall just on one person.

Last year we asked for volunteers in the following areas. We have some folks, but still have areas where we need help. Here is what we are looking at...

- Snow removal -
- Person in charge of garbage -
- Church cleaners - (replacements for Tony, Cheryl) a family or group to handle this
- Someone who works in construction -
- Someone familiar with mechanical -
- Someone to assist with plumbing -
- Someone familiar assist with HVAC -

We do have folks in these areas, but could always use more:

- Cemetery Committee -
- Lawn care -
- Plants/grounds -
- Daily inspection -
- Someone familiar with electrical -
- General volunteers who can help on a project when called --

Now you are probably thinking, oh, am I going to get sucked into this committee and have to spend a thousand hours at church? No. The commitment is to meet about 5 times a year for about an hour each. We also do a summer "walk through" of the parish property which takes 2-3 hours. Then we utilize your skills which might be from nothing to let say 7 hours for a total of 10. Could you commit to that? If everyone chips in, this is pretty simple. Please step up if asked. If you'd like to volunteer, please see one of the committee chairs or me.

Also in the area of parish secretary. At some point Linda will retire. In fact, she sees retirement around the corner. We have been discussing this for some time. As with the Building and Grounds, we plan to get others involved in learning all or portions of Linda's job. It could be as it is now, a half time position, or could be "broken up" (for example Sandy Morris does the bulletin). We would like to train people so we have back-ups for all of the various roles in the job. If you'd be interested, please see Linda or me.

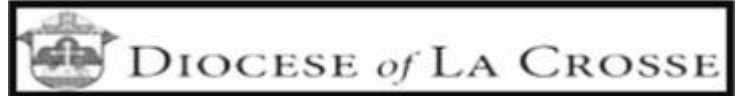
