MacCanon Brown Homeless Sanctuary (MBHS) Food and Crucial Needs

The MBHS Tuesday Doorway Ministry recipients are many. Some individuals represent households of six or more people. They are homeless and people at risk of homelessness. Some live in a variety of homeless situations especially "doubled up homelessness." Many are in extreme need. The majority live in food scarcity.

They are requesting donations of culturally accurate food: canned beef and chicken, spam, sardines, tuna, Vienna sausages, baked beans, SpaghettiOs, canned yams, mac & cheese, Honey Nut Cheerios, and Dinty Moore Stew. There is also a need for Ensure and infant formula.

There is an ongoing need for the following items: Crockpots, electric hotplates, toaster ovens, microwaves, electric skillets, small barbecue grills for people without working stoves. Blenders for people who have trouble chewing. Suitcases with wheels, small shopping carts, wagons and strollers to help people transport the bags of food we give them. The majority of our guests do not have vehicles.


