




PRAYING FOR ALL GOD'S FAMILY

Holy Triduum Invite-Fr. Arul

Brothers and Sisters, I hope that the Passion Sunday Scripture continues to stir your souls as we step into Holy Week. As we journey together, we will enter into the depth of Holy Week, celebrating the Sacred Liturgies of the Holy Triduum with hearts open to the mystery of Christ's love. Holy Week is the heart of our liturgical year. I invite you to participate in the Easter Triduum, the most sacred three days of our faith. Together, let us enter deeply into the Paschal Mystery—the suffering, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Holy Thursday: The Mass of the Lord's Supper will commemorate the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood as we remember Jesus' Last Supper with His disciples. This powerful liturgy, marked by the Washing of the Feet, invites us to embrace Christ's call to serve one another with love and humility. The celebration concludes with the solemn transfer of the Blessed Sacrament to the altar of repose, where we are invited to keep watch with the Lord in prayer.



Good Friday: The Celebration of the Lord's Passion will enter into the solemn remembrance of the Passion and Death of Jesus. Through the reading of the Passion, the Veneration of the Cross, and receiving Holy Communion, we contemplate the depth of Christ's sacrificial love for us. This day of fasting and prayer calls us to reflect on our own journey of faith and repentance.

The Easter Vigil: The Most Holy Night, the Easter Vigil, on Holy Saturday night is the pinnacle of the Church's liturgical year. It is the liturgy of the liturgies, when we celebrate the victory of Christ over sin and death. Beginning in darkness, the Paschal Candle is lit, reminding us that Christ, our Light, has overcome the darkness of the world. We listen to the rich tapestry of salvation history in the Scripture readings, and sing the Alleluia once more, proclaiming Christ's Resurrection.

Please join us in these sacred liturgies as we journey together from the cross to the empty tomb. Let us celebrate Christ's victory over death and His gift of new life.



Spiritual Adoption

Holy Week and Easter Schedule

Holy Week is the last week of Lent which begins with Passion Sunday (known as Palm Sunday) and ends with Easter.

April 13 - Passion (Palm) Sunday - Mass times are at 4:30 pm the night before, 8:00 am, and 10:00 am.
 We will gather as a community to celebrate our Lord's passion on this day. We will remember and relive our Lord's passion by holding the blessed palms in our hands, waving them, singing Hosanna to our Lord. The passion narrative will draw our hearts to participate fully in our Lord's passion.



April 17 - Holy Thursday - Holy Thursday marks the beginning of the Easter Triduum. Join us at **6:30 pm** as we commemorate the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood at our Lord's Last Supper. This liturgy will include the powerful feet washing ceremony, a symbol of humility and service. All are welcome to participate. **The offertory collection will be taken for SVdP.**

April 18 - Good Friday - On Good Friday, we solemnly observe our Lord's passion, suffering, and death. Our service begins at **3:00 pm** reflecting on God's ultimate sacrifice through Jesus Christ out of love for humanity. As we contemplate the Cross, we will have an offertory collection to support the Holy Sites in the Holy Land, and we will fast and pray for all those affected by war. **The offertory collection will be taken for the Holy Land. Read more about this Collection below.**

April 19 - Holy Saturday/Easter Vigil - Holy Saturday is the most sacred night of the liturgical year, culminating in the celebration of our Lord's resurrection. Join us for the **Vigil Mass at 8:00 pm** and join us **for Easter Food Blessing at 11:00 am** in the church.


April 20 - Easter Sunday - Easter Sunday is a day of great joy as we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord! Let us remember that every Sunday is a celebration of this glorious event. **Mass times for Easter Sunday are 8:00 am & 10:00 am.** We are called to participate in the celebration of the day of the Lord and to keep it holy.

Pontifical Good Friday Collection

Pope Francis has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land, where they are now less than 2% of the population. Your support is essential to help the church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools, and offer religious education. The Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines of Christianity, including in Jerusalem, Nazareth, and Bethlehem, to name a few.

The pandemic had hit Christians in the Holy Land particularly hard. Most of them depend on pilgrimages for work. The war made their situation even more dire. In these times of crisis, the Pontifical Good Friday Collection is necessary to meet the basic needs of the People of God still living in this Land and to maintain a Christian presence where the church was born.

When you contribute to the **Pontifical Good Friday Collection**, you join with Catholics around in solidarity with the church in the Holy Land.




