




A special thank you to our youth for another successful mission trip to the Repairer's Of The Breach. Our neighbors experiencing homelessness were delighted to receive our St. Clare & St. Thomas team as we sought to understand and listen to individual stories and struggles at the Repairer's of the Breach. We learned that there are several paths to homelessness and each one is unique. They can include abuse or abandonment. Many people experiencing homelessness have suffered abuse or domestic violence that forced them to flee to the streets for safety. Sometimes this leads to mental illness, trauma, and or addiction. A life-long support system is necessary to overcome the obstacles. Affordable housing is limited and most are on a waitlist. They bide their time in a shelter or on the streets. Employment is difficult to find and keep if you have unaddressed mental or physical health issues, a criminal record or no transportation, or home address. We are talking about fellow human beings who have the same needs and feelings as any of us. Common misconceptions about people experiencing homelessness are that they are lazy, dangerous, or take advantage of what is given to them. This is not always true. We were all very humbled by this amazing serving experience and we are so grateful for our own unrecognized blessings. We concluded our visit with the O'Connor boys singing melodious strains of festive Christmas songs for all to join in. This simple gesture exploded with delight as toothless smiles spread across the dark midwinter of homelessness. Chris O'Connor was nowhere to be found when it was time to leave. Where did he go? In an attempt to help, he guickly went to a local station to buy bus passes for some of the guests.
