PARISH TRUSTEE ELECTION

As a reminder, it's time again to elect two Parish Trustees for St. Mary, Mother of God Parish. *Joan Phillips will be running for re-election. Steven Schumacher's position will be open. Jim Gremminger has been nominated.*

Trustees are to be elected from and by the congregation of our parish. The term of service is a two-year term for trustees.

Nominations are open to registered and active Catholic parishioners who are at least 25 years old. Candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more registered parishioners. Nominations close two weeks prior to the election on January 16. Nominations need to be turned in by Wednesday, December 29.

The election will be held on January 16 with a written ballot before/ after each weekend Mass.


