
Most recently she was the managing editor of a periodical with a circulation of 8,000 and various communications and reporter positions.





#### ADORATION TESTAMONIAL

#### ST. MARY MOTHER OF GOD PARISH CENSUS 2022

Our last parish census was in 2001. A lot has changed since then. So, this year, we will be kicking off Census 2022 by asking all parish members to update their profiles and information. This census will provide valuable information to our staff so that we can better assist and minister to our parish community providing information updates, financial details on donations and maintaining sacramental records. Many of you have switched to cell phones, changed emails, and even moved. In the past year several parishioners have switched to online giving and no longer use envelopes or require a monthly stewardship letter.

#### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence (NCADV) reports that the impact of COVID-19 on domestic violence is still -being assessed. Preliminary indicators are that the pandemic has exacerbated risk factors (isolation, financial stress, etc.)



risk factors (isolation, financial stress, etc.) likely to result in an increase in domestic violence.

At its root, domestic violence involves one intimate partner exercising power and control over another. It often starts with name-calling, threats or distrust. The abuser may go through a phase of apologizing and seeking forgiveness. However, domestic violence tends to escalate and intensify over time into extreme control and abuse. Characteristically, an abuser is extremely jealous, possessive, easily angered, blaming, and controlling. Abusers objectify their victims and consider them as property or sexual objects. They externalize causes of their behavior by blaming their partner, stress, or other reasons.

Last month Pope Francis denounced domestic violence with the following: "For me the problem is nearly satanic, because it's about profiting off the weakness of those who can't defend themselves, who can only try to stop the blows," he said. "It's humiliating, very humiliating."


