

#### Baptism

Infant Baptisms are celebrated during or after Mass once a month (except during Lent). To properly prepare for this sacrament, parents are asked to contact the parish office and to attend a baptismal preparation class.

#### Weddings

To begin your marriage preparation, please call the parish office to setup an appointment to meet with Father.

#### Communion for the Homebound

Please contact the parish office to arrange for regular or occasional visits by the pastoral staff to the homebound or shut-ins. Holy Communion is brought by Father or a Health Ministry volunteer each month.

#### **Eucharistic Assistance**

If you are unable to come forward to receive the Eucharist, a Eucharistic Minister will come to bring Holy Communion to you at the start of the distribution of the Eucharist. Please either stand or raise your hand to indicate that you want to receive the Eucharist. We ask that you sit either in the church at the back to the left of the Baptismal font or in the chapel to facilitate easier distribution.

# THOMPSON CENTER

The Thompson Center on Lourdes had an eventful 2021. Some of our key highlights:

- † 635 New Members / 17,451 Participant Visits
- 113 Unique Programs / 2,180 Total Programs Education, Wellness and Social are the foundation for each program. A sample of these programs included Themed Monthly Drive-throughs, Technology Classes, Pickleball, Book Club, Fused Glass, Chef Showcase, Wood Carving, Line Dancing, Painting, Lunch & amp; Learns, In-Harmony Fox Valley Symphony Orchestra, Tai Chi, on-line videos, and the list goes on.
- † Open 5 Days A Week. On July 6 TCoL went from operating 3 days a week to 5 days without participant limitation and resuming all activities.
- † 57 Community Partners. Working together with other organizations to achieve greater impact and help advance the mission of TCoL. This includes meal service for Outagamie and Calumet Counties.
- † Accreditation -TCoL received accreditation on November 12, 2021, by the Wisconsin Association of Senior Centers. The assessment reviews 22 areas of management to ensure the program is operating at the highest standards. The assessment is invaluable in developing and implementing programs and services for older adults.






# January 31 or February 1 at 7:00 p.m.


