





## Learn Your Faith

The Apostles who followed Christ also followed him in death. With the exception of John the Beloved who died of old age while exiled to the island of Patmos, all of the apostles died as martyrs. Interestingly, John the Beloved was the only apostle at the foot of the cross on Calvary.

Peter died on the cross in Rome on the site where St. Peter's Basilica is built. His death came as a result of Nero using the Christians as a scapegoat for the burning of Rome. Nero used the Christians to hide his incompetence as a ruler. Peter asked that his cross be turned upside down because he did not feel worthy to be crucified in the same manner as Christ. Peter's brother St. Andrew the Protoclete (first called) who was known as the Apostle to the Greeks also died by crucifixion. He was known to have evangelized as far north as modern day Russia and also in Greece and Turkey. Andrew asked to be crucified on a cross that was shaped like an "X," which is now known as St. Andrew's cross. St. Andrew saw the cross as means of perfection back to God and not as a means of torture.

James, the son of Zebedee, and John the Beloved's brother, died at the hands of King Herod Agrippa. We read in Acts 12:1-2, "He had James the brother of John killed by the sword." James had been a key leader of the Church in Jerusalem.

James, the son of Alphaeus, was also a key member of the Church in Jerusalem. He played a significant role in unifying the Christians from the Jewish tradition with those coming from pagan tradition. He also is the author of the Letter of James. He was handed over to the Romans by the High Priest Ananus in the year 62 to be stoned to death.

Matthew the tax collector wrote the Gospel of Matthew for the Hebrews upon his leaving to become a missionary for Christ. He is said to have been executed by a local king in Ethiopia while saying Mass. Philip who is said to have evangelized Greece and then Frisia (on the Greece and Turkey border) is said to have been tortured to death either by crucifixion or stoning in Hierapolis, a city in Frisia.

Thomas the twin evangelized Syria and Persia and then Western and Southern India. He was spared to death in India by a local king for having converted his queen to Christianity. Bartholomew evangelized with Thomas in India and then back to Armenia and then Ethiopia and Southern Arabia. There are various accounts of how he met his death as a martyr.

Simon the Zealot is said to have been killed in Persia for refusing to worship the sun god. Jude Thaddeus, considered the author of The Letter of Jude and who evangelized with Simon, is said to have died by an axe in the same area.

While much of the apostles' work is covered in the Acts of the Apostles, there is much that is not in the Bible. Many books offer insights into their evangelization. It can be very meaningful to get to know more about the apostles and how they spread Christ's message to the world.

We are especially in need of people to fill the time slots from 12 a.m. on Saturday through 12 p.m. on Sunday. Will you prayerfully consider taking an hour?



An Adoration reflection:

***"Doing nothing often leads to the very best kind of something."***

Yes, this may be a quote from Winnie the Pooh, but I think it accurately describes how I think about Adoration. As a current sophomore in high school, it feels as though I am always doing something. Whether it be homework, practicing having a driver's license, helping out at home with daily needs, or trying to find time to work after school and on weekends, there's never a boring or dull moment in my life. Adoration is an experience unlike anything else I have experienced in my life. It gives me an opportunity to step away from the busy world and take a deep breath.

For many people, I know the silence of Adoration is a struggle. It is hard for them to come pray or talk to God when He doesn't always talk back. They might give up because of frustration or lack of knowing what to do in Adoration. This is where the quote from Pooh comes in; sometimes, you have to start by doing nothing. A few times during my weekly Holy Hour, I will just sit and think, enjoy the silence, or admire the beauty of Jesus as the Eucharist displayed in the monstrance, as well as appreciate the incredible blessing we have at this parish to have almost Perpetual Adoration.

Sometimes this simple act of doing nothing leads to a thought, feeling, or idea that comes over you and you just know that it wasn't entirely your body causing that reaction. I believe that this is the "very best kind of something" that is a result of Adoration: the ability to come with your struggling, anxious mind and leave feeling refreshed and calm.

So, why did I feel compelled to write this? It was actually an inspiration I felt in Adoration. I want my experience to inspire and encourage people to go to Adoration. It may be late, but you could make it your Lenten promise to go to Adoration at least once a week, and once you make it a practice, you can carry it over to more than just during Lent. I was already going to Adoration every Tuesday with my mom, but we added every Thursday for Lent and I don't see why we would ever stop.

Adoration is a commitment that has changed my life, changed the way I deal with my struggles, and changed the way I cope with my worries and all that life throws at me. Once again, I encourage you all to sign up for a Holy Hour, I promise it will change your life, and it can get us closer to Perpetual Adoration! I want to end by leaving you all with a question, if you aren't signed up for Adoration right now, what is keeping you from that?

I think the biggest thing I have noticed in people when I ask them is that they don't have enough time. One of the biggest impacts that Adoration has had on my life is it has helped me recognize the places I am spending the most time. I noticed that I was spending time on lots of unnecessary things: social media, procrastination of homework, etc. I now am able to use Adoration as an incentive to get my necessities finished and therefore have a clearer mind in Adoration and have that be the end of my night instead of staying up doing homework after 10:00 when my Holy Hour ends.

If this resonates with you, again, I encourage you to sign up for Adoration and watch how it changes you for the better.






