

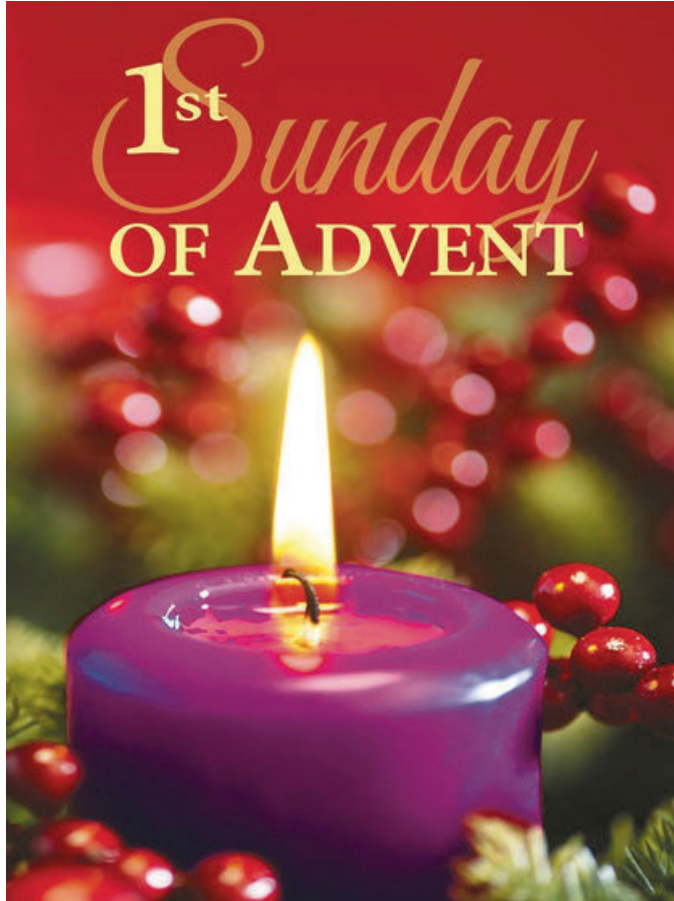

LOVE ONE ANOTHER CAMPAIGN UPDATE



St. Francis Borgia parishioners have pledged approximately \$3.5 million to the Love One Another (“LOA”) campaign. Since our last update in May 2022, the parish received an additional \$53,000 of its estimated \$2.4 million share of the campaign pledges, bringing total parish receipts from the campaign to \$806,000. Our parish receives its share of donor payments from the campaign as they are received at the Archdiocese. LOA pledges are expected to be collected over a five year period, with 38% percent of pledged amounts already collected. Approximately 40% of parishioners that made a LOA pledge have already paid it in full. Thank you for your generous support!

As a reminder, the three focus projects identified by St. Francis Borgia for its LOA funds were:

- 1. retire the remaining E&AC construction debt
- 2. North Church updates and maintenance
- 3. South Church maintenance & renovations.
- The approximate \$336,000 E&AC debt outstanding at the beginning of calendar 2022 has been repaid with approximately \$282,000 of LOA proceeds and the approximate \$54,000 of then-remaining restricted E&AC funds. As of today, the parish is debt-free.
- The roofs of the North Church, parish center and rectory have all been replaced over the last 90 days, at a total cost of approximately \$316,000. The roof replacements follow a \$400,000+ upgrade to its heating and air conditioning systems a few years back. No additional major work is planned on North Church projects in the next twelve months.
- The next project to be undertaken with LOA campaign funds will be exterior repairs and improvements on the South Church, including painting, tuck-pointing and window repair. Because there are several weddings already scheduled in the South Church throughout calendar 2023, no interior work will be undertaken in 2023.
- As of Oct. 31, 2022 the parish had approximately \$208,000 of remaining funds on hand from LOA receipts that are segregated in a restricted bank account and set aside for 2023 South Church work. Future receipts will be added to these funds and will dictate the pace and timing of additional North and South Church projects over the next three years.

Due to the leadership and work of many volunteers in the fundraising phase of the campaign, and the generosity of parishioners that made pledges, our parish is able to tackle these maintenance and improvement projects. Thank you very much!

Year End Financial Information

As the end of 2022 approaches, here are a few things you should be aware of regarding your St. Francis Borgia charitable donations. These guidelines correspond to IRS regulations which stipulate that there is no donor “election” as to which calendar year the donation applies. Donations must actually be ‘paid’ before the close of the tax year to be deductible in that tax year. This includes:

- **In person payments-** we would like to accommodate all our parishioners while respecting the holiday work hours of our office staff so we ask that you please plan ahead to ensure that all in person checks are brought to the office before the office closes at 4:30 PM on Friday, 12/30/22. If you miss that deadline but want to make a 2022 donation please consider our easy to use online giving tool located on our parish website: <https://abundant.co/sfbgiving/give>
- **US Mail-** donations postmarked December 31st or earlier, but received in January 2023, will be credited to the date on the check. Therefore, if the envelope is postmarked 2022 and the check is dated for 2023, the contribution will be credited to your account for 2023; however, if the contribution is postmarked 2022, and received in 2022, the check will be credited to your 2022 donations even if the check date is dated 2023.
- **Stock Transfer-** in the case of stock transfers, the donation date is the date you (the donor) relinquish control of the stock, not the date that St. Francis Borgia (the organization) receives it.
- **Online Donations-** the easiest way to ensure your donation is credited to the tax year you want is by making an online donation. All online donations completed by midnight on 12/31/22, will be considered a 2022 donation. Online donations can be made through this link on our St. Francis Borgia Parish website giving tool at: <https://abundant.co/sfbgiving/give>

If you are planning a donation that you wish to be credited for 2022, the sooner you can accomplish this, the better. Please note that the last week of the calendar year our parish office will be closed Mon. 12/26/22, and open Tues.-Fri., from 8:30 a.m. -4:30 p.m. Year-end contribution statements reflecting your 2022 donation will be sent no later than 1/31/23. 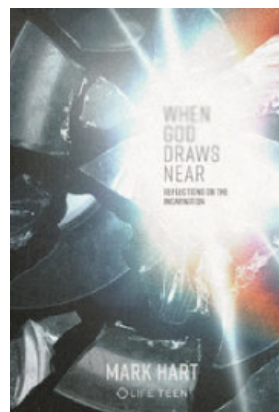
