

Fr. Al Veik Thank You Weekend Jan. 21-22

Hospitality and Fellowship Following All Masses

This weekend we will be honoring Fr. Al Veik and his many years of service at St. Francis Borgia Parish. Ordained to the priesthood in 1967, Fr. Al's first assignments consisted of serving as a seminary teacher and director of formation for his religious community, the Capuchins. In 1975, Fr. Al began ministering to inmates at the Milwaukee County Jail and developed a jail chaplaincy program.

Fr. Al began assisting at St. Francis Borgia Parish in the 1980s. We have been blessed through the many years he has helped at our parish through celebrating sacraments, teaching our youth and presiding at Masses - most commonly 6 p.m. on Sunday evenings.

Fr. Al will preside at all Masses January 21-22 with hospitality and fellowship to follow. In his honor, a second collection will be taken to benefit Works of Mercy Ministry, a program close to Fr. Al's own heart. This ministry serves persons with special needs and chronic mental illness and assists them in helping others in need.

Grateful For People, Prayer & Parish

Catholic Faith Formation for our middle school and high school youth is vital to the future of our Church. It's imperative that each young person be relying on virtuous people, prayer, and their parish as they journey in faith. At St. Francis Borgia we are blessed with faithful praying, zealous, dedicated faith formation leaders, and a parish focused on deepening our relationship with Christ through prayer, knowledge, liturgy and the sacraments.

Over the last 5 years, since we brought the Life Teen formation model to our parish, we have seen steady growth and consistent engagement from our young Catholics. This year we have grown to more than 200 middle and high schoolers registered for faith formation at St. Francis Borgia. In formation, they gather and reconnect with one another and then pray and learn in a large group. Afterwards, they break into small groups where they are invited to share their journey and what God is doing in their lives as well as to ask questions about the Catholic Faith and how they are to live it. They close in prayer and have time to reflect upon the ways in which the Lord, their families, and their faith community is giving them strength and encouragement to stay close to Jesus as he calls them to their life's mission. They are sent forth from formation to be the light of Christ to others.

Every person in our parish plays a role in the formation of our youth. Please include them in your prayer each week. Pray that their understanding of the faith and their trust in the Lord is deepening. If you've heard the Lord calling you to be more involved in the faith formation of our youth, please reach out to us in Youth Ministry and we'll be happy to talk with you about the gifts the Lord has given you that can be shared with our young faithful!
