A word from Fr. Matthew Ferch



This week, on June 11, we celebrate St. Barnabas. St. Barnabas was a part of the early Church. He was well established within the community. He was sent to Antioch to help the Church there when the Church in Antioch was growing. Barnabas is remembered for being a traveling companion to St. Paul where he accompanied him on his missionary journey. They went through a lot together—preaching the Good News to those who had never heard it. We see in *Acts of the Apostles* as well as Paul's letters that they found success in their missionary efforts.

This gives me thought about how we all are called to missionary work just like St. Barnabas. Jesus told us at the Great Commission to go, and teach the nations. We do not necessarily have to go to far away lands to preach the Gospel. We are all called to be missionaries in our daily lives! There are people all around us who have not heard the Good News, and there may be some people who may need to hear it again. Let us not be afraid to spread the message of Jesus to everybody we meet. We do that through our words and actions. Let all our actions be acts of love and charity. Let all of our words come from a place of care and concern. That way, people can see that our actions are rooted in Christ (which brings us true happiness and joy) and our words proclaiming Christ come from a place of deep faith and belief in the saving power of God.
