The following parishioners are celebrating Birthdays and Anniversaries this week

Getting to know Fr. Mac

As Fr. Savio mentioned last weekend, Fr. Mac will be celebrating our liturgies for the next six weeks while he is on vacation in India. For those who don't know Fr. Mac very well, we thought we'd share some info about him...

Fr. James P. McNamee was born on April 16, 1946 and grew up in the house where he presently lives, just west of St. John's church in Montello. Fr. Mac was the only child of John and Anne McNamee who were very active members of St. John's and Fr. Mac attended St. John the Baptist Grade School and Montello High School. Father went on to UW-Stevens Point where he earned a B.S. degree in economics in June 1968. From 1962-1968, Father worked part time at the Montello State Bank and from 1968-1972 he worked at the Westfield State Bank (now BMO). Following graduation at Stevens Point, he entered St. Francis Seminary in Milwaukee and graduated in May, 1973 with his Masters degree in Theology. Fr. Mac was ordained a deacon on April 8, 1972 and ordained to the priesthood on June 2, 1973 at St. Joseph the Workman Cathedral in La Crosse. His first Mass was celebrated at St. John the Baptist in Montello on June 3, 1973.

Following ordination, Fr. Mac served as an Parochial Vicar at St. Lawrence in Wisconsin Rapids and St. Stephen in Stevens Point. From August 1982 to January, 1990, Fr. Served as the Pastor of St. Jerome in Wonewoc, St. Teresa in Union Center and St. Patrick in Elroy. While in Wonewoc, he built a new parish center. In February 1990, Father was transferred to St. Stanislaus and Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Arcadia where he remained until September 1994. He then served as Pastor of St. Joseph in Kendall, St. Patrick in Elroy and St. John the Baptist in Wilton until June 2003. In July of 2003, Father was appointed Pastor of St. Joseph in Adams and St. Anne in Brooks where he remained until he retired on June 30, 2016. While in Adams, he built the new church for St. Joseph parish which is located on County J in Friendship. Upon retirement, Fr. Mac returned to his family home in Montello where he lives today. He's active in the Montello community and has made many friends in his retirement. Fr. Mac serves as a help out priest in many of the area parishes including Princeton, Neshkoro, Green Lake, Berlin, Pardeeville, Buffalo, Markesan, Kingston and Adams/Friendship. He is very much enjoying his retirement because it allows him to focus on what he was ordained for ...administering the sacraments instead of the administration of a parish. We look forward to having him with us through February 27th.

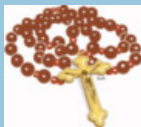
Soup & Sandwich January 31st
