

Reflections from Fr. Mac

While Fr. Mac was a Parochial Vicar at St. Stephen's Parish in Stevens Point, he was the chaplain of the Serra Club of Stevens Point. Serrans are Catholics committed to Christian leadership at home, at work, and in the Church. They foster and affirm vocations to the priesthood, religious life and ministries of the Church. As part of his work with Serra, he shared a series of short inspirational talks called "spiritual quickenings" Their purpose is to deepen our spirituality and help to develop a better understanding of our Christian vocation; and a vocation to the priesthood or religious life.

Here are a few "spiritual quickenings" Fr. Mac would like to share with us:

- My dad often said, "talk is cheap but it takes money to buy whiskey." Advice is often cheap; good counseling worthwhile. The difference between the two is that when we give advice we tell others what we would do in the same or a given circumstance. In counseling, we try to evoke the true feelings and an honest response from the counselee for the given circumstance. So when in need, seek competent, professional help at the onset, not when the problem is so great that it just may be uncorrectable. When you do not know what you want, you usually get what you do not want.
- How often have you signed your name below the words "sincerely yours?" Sincere comes from two Latin words meaning without wax: free from any deceit or phoniness. Do not just use the word live it; remembering that Plato said "The mask an actor wears is apt to become his face."
- A Professor of Business and Economics was giving a talk on Business Ethics. I called to the attention of the membership two quotations. Matthew 18:20 "Where two or there are gathered in my name, there I am in the midst of them." and Adam Smith in the Wealth of Nations (1776) "Two people of the same profession seldom get together without contriving to raise prices."


6-Week Small Group Bible Study for Lent






