

Dear Friends,

Be a messenger of hope. In Dante's *Inferno*, the inscription on the gates of hell reads, "Lasciate ogni speranza, voi ch'entrate." It translates, "Abandon all hope, ye who enter." Hell is the place where there is no hope. It is the most painful feeling one can experience. In our world today there are many people who feel there is no hope. Things are only getting worse. For many, it is impossible to look at the world and be hopeful. Accompanying this hopelessness is also blame. It is somebody's fault my world is in such bad shape. Anger, frustration, depression, suspicion, powerlessness, and fear are also signs that hope is missing. One who buys into such a vision, does not need a God to send them to hell, they have accepted it on their own.

Christianity is a religion of hope. It offers us expectation; that is, a reason to move forward even when faced with what seems to be an impossible task. The scriptures are filled with stories of people who seemed defeated, only to rise again by the hand of God. The most famous is the death of Jesus on the cross. On the third day, Jesus rose from the dead. Every death is followed by life. Every winter is followed by spring. I cannot think of a more hopeful message. Where discouragement is understandable, the negativity of hopelessness is not a Christian message. We are called to bring hope to a sinful world.

I suppose we could all talk about it, but the best way to proclaim hope is to live it. Hope is what allows a person to be generous even when they are worried there may not be enough for them. Hope is what calls us to forgive, even when we still hurt and are not sure the other person is sorry. Hope is what asks us to accompany another, even when our heart is broken.

Jesus teaches us to live in hope through the beatitudes. (Matthew 5:1 ff) His words offer us a remedy for the troubles of life. He also calls us to be that medicine. If all we hear are gripes or complaints about the condition of our world, we run the risk of becoming a hopeless person. However, if we ask for the grace to share and forgive and open our heart to our brothers and sisters, we will start to see something different. That expectation will change our view of life. It will make us a welcomed message of hope in a troubled world. It will make us a true and positive disciple of Christ.
