



## Financial Aid for Catholic Education

St. Mary's Congregation is offering financial aid in support of families sending their children to St. Joseph Catholic Academy and All Saints Catholic School. These programs are open to all registered, active members of the Parish.

The Tuition Assistance grant is to families that might not be financially able to send their children to St. Joes or All Saints. This program is not limited to either school or to any particular grade level but is based on need. The amount to be given is at the discretion of the Pastor with the assistance of the selection committee. Tuition Assistance applications are available in the parish office and can also be found on the Parish's website. The Application with all required supporting documents are due in the Parish Office by noon on April 30, 2021. If you have any questions regarding the Tuition Assistance program you can contact Fr. The second program is the St. Mary's Scholarship program that the parish has offered for a number of years to worthy eighth grade students who will attend St. Joseph Academy as a ninth grader for the 2021-2022 school year. The Parish is again offering two one-time scholarships of \$500.00. Scholarship applications are available in the parish office, and at All Saints School and St. Joe's upper campus. Applications can also be found on the Parish's website as well as the St. Joe's and All Saint's websites. The Application and the necessary supporting documents must be received at the Parish office by noon on April 7, 2021.

## CALLED, NAMED, AND SENT

Each of us carries a lifetime of memories, sad and happy images that cram our long-term memory and often come spilling out when least expected. A chance comment, a long forgotten song, a detour to an old neighborhood, or some other prompt has the power to trigger our memory and pull out images that take us back to another time. Recalling past events often generate unforgettable images of past tragedies and treasures that we continually balance against our present day hopes and joys.

**Happy are those who dream dreams and are ready to pay the price to make them come true."**

Our Gospel account today could be entitled: "A-day-in-the-life-of-Jesus." It reveals what his typical day must have been like. He struggled to balance the needs of others with his need for prayer and quiet time, so that he too could bring God's love and hope to others. It was his love that brought that hope---hope in him, hope for salvation, and hope for healing and forgiveness. Jesus provides us with a model for our journeys as well. It is our role as disciples to continue to bring that same hope to all whom we meet.

It is hope that allows us to persevere despite rejection and numerous difficulties. Leo-Josef Cardinal Suenens of Belgium, a key figure of the Second Vatican council, expressed his hope in the face of great resistance. He said, *"I am a man of hope, not for human reasons nor from any natural optimism, but I believe the Holy Spirit is at work in the church and in the world, even when unrecognized and unnamed. ...To hope is not to dream but to turn dreams into reality. Happy are those who dream dreams and are ready to pay the price to make them come true."*

This definition from Cardinal Suenens certainly fits the lives of spiritual leaders who have found themselves faced with great odds. We all know such people. They keep commitments, and they demonstrated an awareness of the needs of others, especially the poor and the marginalized. We call them disciples, people who commit themselves to bring the love of Jesus Christ to others, across the street and across the world. It is a journey to which we are all called, and a goal for all who wish to be disciples of Jesus Christ. That journey takes a lifetime and is never a smooth ride!

**Each of us is called to discipleship. In our struggle to understand and maintain a balance between what God calls us to do and what we might find more appealing, we learn the lesson experienced by all disciples. Discipleship is not all glitz and glamour, fulfillment and recognition. It is also not all work. Rather following Jesus requires quiet moments, prayerful reflection and a focus upon Jesus so that the suffering and rejection, the loneliness and the discouragement that are, at times, an inevitable part of belonging to Christ, may be borne with grace and hope.**

Our greatest gifts, our most enduring memories, and our most incredible images of hope are seen on the smiling faces of others, and the commitment and dedication of all who work to bring light to those in need. Being faithful to that call changes us and we are never the same.


