- ◆ How is every baptized person called to participate in the mission of the Church? What areas of mission are we neglecting?
- ◆ What relationships does our Church community have with members of other Christian traditions and denominations? What do we share and how do we journey together?
- ◆ How is authority and governance exercised within our local Church (diocese/parish)? How are teamwork and co-responsibility put into practice?
- ◆ What is our experience of celebrating the Eucharist? What are some ways our parishes and diocese can place greater emphasis on realizing the infinite value of the Eucharist within our Christian life?

Aid me by Your grace to practice the divine lessons of humility, poverty, obedience, and contempt of the world, which Jesus taught us in His mortal life. Amen.*

## From the Pastor's Desk...

### *Ave Maria, Regina Angelorum! Hail Mary, Queen of Angels!*

Peace be with you! "Christ's peace is the fruit of the redemption that he brought into the world by his death and resurrection – the gift that the Risen Lord continues to give even today to his Church as she gathers for the celebration of the Eucharist." This is a quote from a 2014 document promulgated by the Congregation for Divine Worship (CDW) regarding the sign of peace. This document teaches that the sign of peace is meant "to manifest peace, communion and charity" and that by offering a sign of peace at this time in the Mass, the Church "implores peace and unity for herself and for the whole human family, and the faithful express to each other their ecclesial communion and mutual charity before communicating in the Sacrament."

In the Bishop's still-current directives for conducting public liturgies, he asks that the sign of peace not involve physical contact "out of respect for those who would prefer that approach," and in his apostolic exhortation *Sacramentum Caritatis*, then-pope Benedict XVI wrote about the greater restraint needed in this liturgical gesture "which can be exaggerated and cause a certain distraction in the assembly just before the reception of Communion. It should be kept in mind that nothing is lost when the sign of peace is marked by a sobriety which preserves the proper spirit of the celebration, as, for example, when it is restricted to one's immediate neighbours." Thus, the CDW instructs us that the faithful are not to move "from their places to exchange the sign of peace amongst themselves."

In this new year, as we gather as a parish family for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, let's remember Jesus' words to the apostles at the Last Supper: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." I close with the final words from the CDW document: "Christ is our peace, that divine peace, announced by the prophets and by the angels, and which he brought to the world by means of his paschal mystery. This peace of the Risen Lord is invoked, preached and spread in the celebration, even by means of a human gesture lifted up to the realm of the sacred." ~Fr. Zak
