## From the Pastoral Associate's Desk...

*"I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" -Luke 12:49*

The Holy Spirit has been sent into the world, setting the hearts of the first disciples on fire with the love of God. This love naturally impelled them to *go out* into the unknown, into the depths, into the darkness to bring the blazing, glorious, light of Christ into the world.

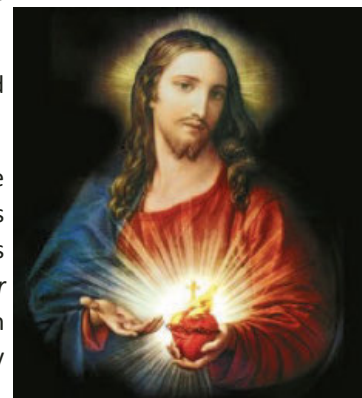
That's great...but what about us? If we don't know Jesus, we won't be motivated to share anything about Him with others. The first step in this journey of faith is to draw close to the Lord. Visit Him in prayer, in the Sacraments, in Adoration, in Scripture. Listen for His word. Seek to grow in holiness. Let Him speak to your heart.

The Christian life does not primarily consist in following the moral teachings, the "rules" and "thou shalt nots" of our faith. Those exist to protect and preserve the relationship! The "rules" in a marriage mean that a husband or wife shouldn't act like they are married to someone else, but that is not the essence of marriage...a marriage is about a very real love between the husband and wife! This love can only come through time, honesty, vulnerability, openness, and loving action. The same is true for our relationship with God.

If you are excited to tell people about your spouse, your significant other, your children, or your grandchildren, it is because you love them and want to share the joy of that relationship with someone else. The same is true with Jesus. If you love Him and see how deeply He has loved you from the very beginning, it will move your heart to share this joy with others too. Listen for His word – which will be personal and unique to each of us.

Jesus wants the earth to be set ablaze with loving hearts. This requires the effort of preparing and kindling a fire for Jesus to ignite deep inside us.

This Sunday, as we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, let us consider the ongoing love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as a divine dance, an ongoing movement of love that draws us spiritually upward in the most captivating experience we could imagine. That is what God desires with you for all eternity. It requires being open to the invitation of this dance and to trust *with our whole heart* that God loves us as His own children and wants to bring us greater joy than we can conceive. So, be not afraid! And be open to the fire of the Holy Spirit doing something powerfully transformative and new in your life! God bless you. ~Chris
