From the Office of Liturgy & Music

You may have noticed we are singing different "Alleluias" each week. Why is that?

These Alleluias and verses come out of something called the "Graduale Romanum," or the "Roman Gradual". What is this, you may ask? It is the book of the official words and melodies of the sung prayers of the Mass. It includes all three antiphons, the psalm, the gradual, and sequences. The Church allows for new settings of musical accompaniment for these words, so long as the Gradual's melody is intact, or in great pastoral need, simplified. However, the already written melodies are to be used if able. This means, in all simplicity, that the Church gives us a preferred set of music to sing every Mass, and when the Church prefers that we do something, we should always make a deference to the Church.

The weekly changing of these melodies can add quite a lot to a Mass. In addition to the extra scriptural texts that these add, it also gives the musical feelings the Church wants for each Mass, whether joyful, or more dour. We can use these formal texts and melodies to guide our choices for the rest of the music, whether the processional and recessional, or the music used during Mass.

So why don't most parishes which say the Mass of Pope Paul VI (our Mass) use it? Quite simply, because it's easier to use the same music at every Mass. It takes less practice on the organist and choir's part, and the people don't have to think as much about the music they are singing and hearing during the Mass.

Something impressive about this parish is that the people sing, and sing quite well, even when the music could be considered complicated for any other parish! We, as a parish, are more than capable of singing these melodies, and as such, we should be singing them. The Lord has given us a great treasure through His earthly Church, let us rejoice in that gift!
