From the Pastor's Desk...

This weekend we celebrate with the Rite of Installation of Pastor, a short and yet incredibly beautiful Rite of the Church. I first want to thank all of those involved in the planning of this event, from the Liturgy to the reception. There are a lot of behind the scenes details, and I am most grateful to everyone who helped. I also want to thank Fr. Tom Shoemaker, Pastor of St. Charles and our Vicar for Vicariate D, for representing Bishop Rhoades and installing me as the eleventh pastor of Queen of Angels.

In these times of transition, it is always helpful for us to refocus and to understand what exactly is happening, or what the importance of having a "pastor" is. Thankfully for us, the Church provides guidelines for what the role of a pastor is meant to achieve in the Code of Canon Law, Her governing body of rules and directions. In the Code, Holy Mother Church instructs that the Pastor is first and foremost to care pastorally for the community that is entrusted to him. From the beginning of time, God knew that all of us, both you and myself, would call Queen of Angels home at this point in time. In God's infinite wisdom, and with the cooperation of man, he has led Bishop to install me as pastor, with my chief duties being to teach, to sanctify, and to govern all of the souls residing within our parish boundaries and who attend our Sunday Masses. These three important duties will help guide in the decisions made, while being firmly rooted in Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, and the magisterial teachings of the Church. Each of these will aid in proclaiming the Word of God in its entirety, while providing opportunities for growth for all of our parishioners, from the youngest member to the eldest.

One of the most important duties of a pastor, however, is incredibly fitting for our time now. As we are still beginning this three-year Eucharistic Revival period in the Church in the United States, I am reminded that at the heart of the responsibilities of the pastor is to make the Most Holy Eucharist the center of the Parish. This is done through reverent and devout celebration of the Sacraments, of instructing the faithful about the mysteries of the faith, and encouraging the frequent use of the Sacraments, especially Reconciliation and worthy reception of Holy Communion.

When understanding the duties and responsibilities of the Pastor, it is understood to be no small feat. And that is why I ask you to please keep me in your prayers. The Lord is at work in this community, and my job, with your aid, is to help continue the growth and love of the Lord, through the Word of God and the Celebration of the Sacraments, especially the Most Holy Eucharist. *Fr.
