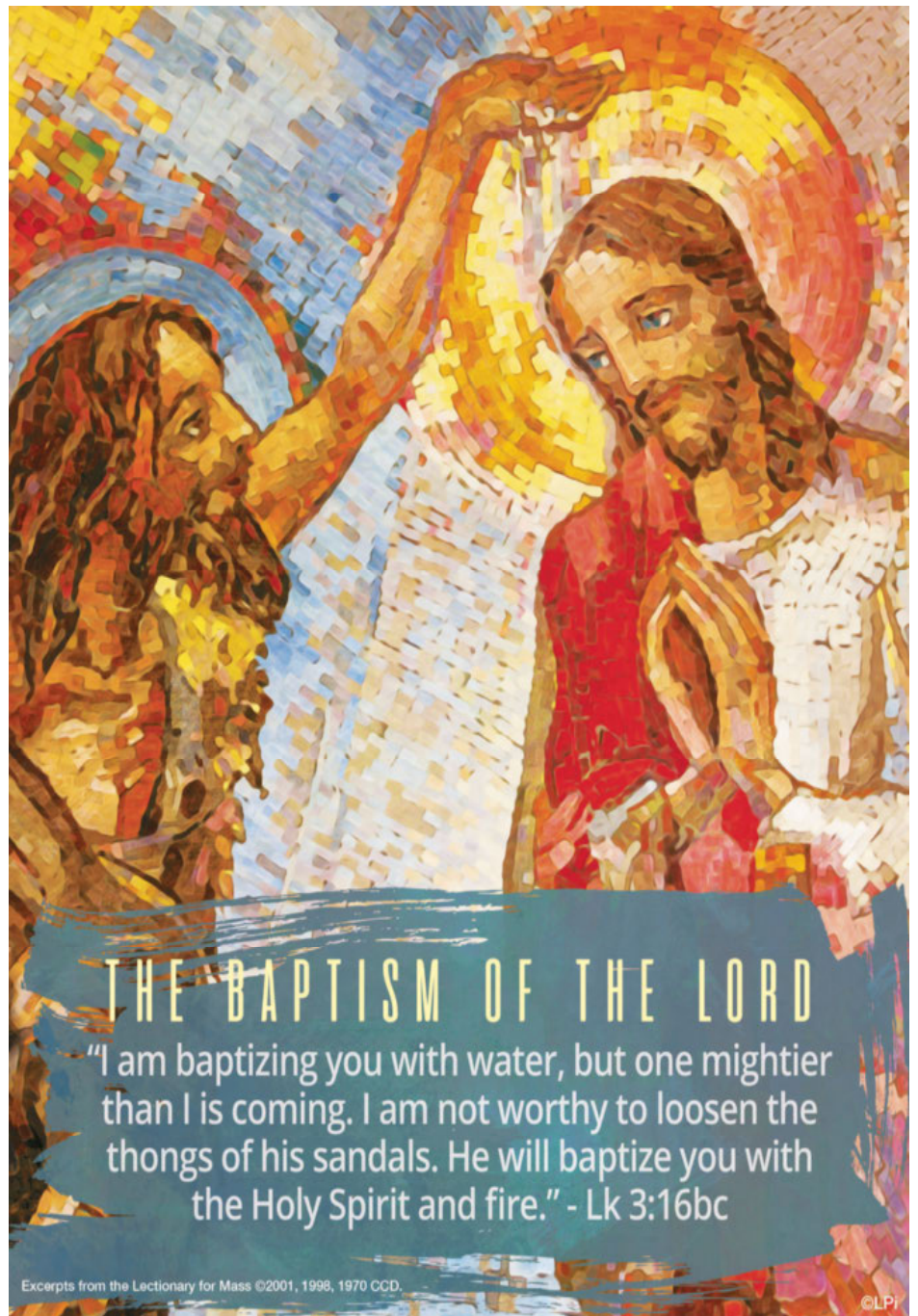

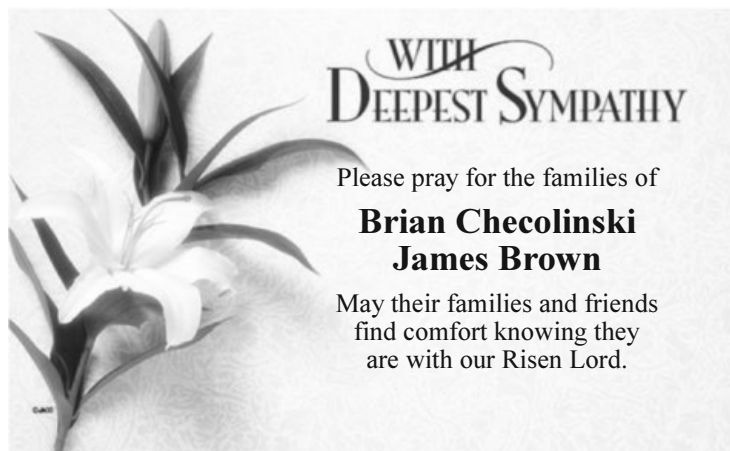

- ◆ Bottles, Boppy nursing pillows, and nursing pads

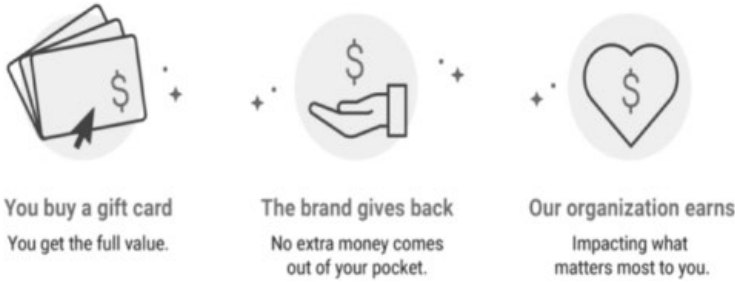
