



As I am always proud of Catholic Education, I am looking forward to celebrating our St. Kilian Catholic School Week that kicks off this Sunday, January 30 through February 5, 2022. Please join me in thanking our principal, **Jenny Trimberger**, and our amazing team of teachers, staff, volunteers, and the members of the school committee for their service to our school. We acknowledge all those who support our school in various capacities. Some parish families have helped our students with tuition assistance last year and this year, which signifies their love and passion for the Catholic Education. I would like to ask our parishioners to simply spread the word about our school and its enrollment opportunities to your families, relatives, friends, co-workers, neighbors and the communities where you live. Your help is much appreciated!

<u>Update about Mass Vestments</u>: St. Kilian has been **overwhelmed with donations** for purchasing new chasubles for Mass and other liturgical events. We have ordered everything that we needed. Actually, we wanted to complete this project by the end of December, 2021. We then realized that our project was interrupted by product shortages and delays due to many shutdowns in Europe and other vestment companies in our country. The good news is that we got most of the chasubles, including one from Belgium. What normally takes 6-8 weeks to customize, chasubles could now take 12-16 weeks or longer to come to completion. I, along with one of our parishioners, are going to Chicago to a vestment company this week. We are hoping to have everything in our closet by the end of March, 2022. Once we have everything, we will provide an update.

Due to Covid situations and other concerns, two children couldn't make their First Communion last Spring. Now they are prepared to receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion at St. Kilian at the 4:30 PM Mass on Saturday, February 5th. Let's continue to pray for them and their families. Let our First Communicants be nurtured and strengthened in their faith.

A Word From Seminarian Brian Ward...



Many of you may have seen me in the last few months sitting at Mass or standing in the back of church after Mass. I am a man studying to become a priest and have been doing this at St. Francis de Sales Seminary since the Fall of 2020.

The Christmas Season is past us now, but I wanted to reflect on what I did and where I went. Being initially from Indiana, and this is where my family still lives, I went there for Christmas. One thing I did that I enjoyed was to help with youth ministry at a "lock-in", where we played Christmas games and enjoyed Christmas sweets. One young man who is a high school senior and discerning to go to the Seminary, led a great reflection about gratitude. He shared a story of a girl telling her father that she had a bad day at school, but then the father showed her a picture of a needy person in another country. The father was teaching his child the lesson of being grateful for what we have and not complaining about petty things in life.

I then went to Independence, an hour north of La Crosse, WI, at my home parish of Sts. Peter and Paul. I went to speak to the grade school students about life as a seminarian and vocations, which was enjoyable for me. I really enjoy Christmas because of the time spent with family and friends and giving to others. A time to remember that life is about joy in the newborn Christ and how we can serve other people, especially those in the most need of help. Helping others does not necessarily mean going out to the homeless or poor, which is indeed a great thing. I had helped the poor on Christmas Day when I was a brother with the Marian Fathers and remember this to be one of the best Christmas Days I have ever had. Helping others can also mean helping others in our own homes by being a good spouse, parent, child, or sibling. Sometimes we can miss some things that are so basic that we then take them for granted. My hope and prayer is for all of you not to forget the blessings of Christmas joy with family and live year-round with much gratefulness of heart.




