

Catholic Stewardship Appeal Update

The 2022 campaign, "Many Hands, One Vision", has begun and already St. Kilian and St. John have strongly committed to supporting this appeal. Currently, **St. Kilian has contributed \$26,538 towards the goal of \$45,900. St. John has contributed \$5,855 towards the goal of \$14,280**. This year's goal for the Archdiocese is \$8.1 million. Along with the monetary goal, the campaign is also hoping to increase overall participation.

Like previous years, the appeal provides Catholics an opportunity to support a wide range of ministries and programs that benefit more than 500,000 people each year with their support. One of the key beneficiaries of this appeal is the support of the formation of our future priests. In 2021, Archbishop ListECKI ordained 3 new priests. This year there were 6 ordained as Transitional Deacons in April for our Archdiocese and 6 new priests will be ordained in May at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist.

Pastoral Staff Introduction: Dennis Vlasak

Hello! My name is Dennis Vlasak, and I am the Director of Christian Formation here at St. Kilian. I look forward to continuing working with the parish and our families to continue the mission of providing educational and spiritual formation while identifying and fulfilling the needs of families and parishioners of all ages, building up the Body of Christ within and beyond our parish community through evangelization and service.

I have served in the role of Director since Summer of 2015. Prior to that, I was the part-time Youth Minister since 2011. I also serve on the board of Mareda, the Archdiocesan association of Directors of Religion. In 2020, I was selected to be a member of the Archbishop's Order of Catechists. This is a group that works and prays for families and passing on the faith within the Church.

I received Eucharist, Reconciliation, and Confirmation at what was then St. George Parish in Elkhart Lake. My parents moved to Slinger when I was a junior in high school. My father was a teacher at Slinger High School. I was a member of the choir and a lector at St. Peter, Slinger, while I was in high school.

I have always had an interest in my faith and sharing it with others. It was when I was at UWM in the early 80's that I had the opportunity to make my faith my own. When I first moved to Milwaukee while attending UWM, I had that "I am free of my parents and their rules" moment. However, by the third week of living on my own, I just had to find a church that I could attend. Mass and the Catholic Faith were just such a part of the fabric of my life. After checking out a number of parishes that were relatively close to the dorms, I met someone who invited me to attend Mass with them at the Newman Center on campus. I fell in love with that community and found a home. I attended everything that I could at the Newman Center: Mass, prayer services, talks, Tenebrae services, social events. I attended my first Triduum there. It was there at the Newman Center that I made the faith that I was raised in, my own. It was because of the Newman Center and the priest and sister that ministered there, along with other Catholic young adults, that I am who I am.

After I graduated college the first time, I went back to St. Peter, Slinger, and volunteered to be a catechist. That was in 1982. Later I moved to Milwaukee where I worked in restaurants. For a number of years, I was the unpaid Liturgist at St. Bernadette Parish on the northwest side of Milwaukee while being a Confirmation Catechist there. With the exception of a short time when I moved and was raising my son, I have been in catechesis ever since. Goodness, that is 40 years! I have been a member of St. Kilian since 1996. My son, Michael, who many of you saw grow up in the parish, went through the formation program here and is now nearly 24.

I have had more different jobs than any one person should probably have. I have always been a bit stubborn I've been told. At that time, I had a "nudging" of God in the back of my mind, but that didn't fit into what I thought I wanted to do. I wanted what I wanted. God was important in my life, but I wanted to do what I was interested in and try new things. I would work at a job for a number of years and then have a restlessness that I needed to move on. Sometimes this moving on included going back to college. After talking with my spiritual director at the time, Sr. Mary Hope, I realized that I would not be happy in my occupation if I did not surrender myself and listen to that "nudging" from God. So much of my formation has been at the hands of the School Sisters of Notre Dame. After a lot of talking with Sr. Mary Hope, it was then that I decided I needed to let go and let God steer me where He wanted me. I needed to listen to that part of the Lord's Prayer that says, "Thy will be done." Soon after I became the Youth Minister at St. Kilian.

The ministry that I perform here at St. Kilian includes coordinating the Christian Formation Program for all parish children in grades 4K through 12, recruiting, overseeing, and providing training of the catechists that work with the children, as well as supervising the RCIA process. St. Kilian currently has 25 catechists working with the children and teens of the parish. This year I am also teaching middle school religion classes at St. Kilian School. You may also see me taking on other roles, especially in liturgy, that are typically done by a liturgist or a pastoral associate.

It gives me such pleasure to work with children and see them growing in their faith and love of the Lord. I love my ministry, and I am so incredibly lucky to minister in my own parish—a parish that is home for me and that I love so dearly!




