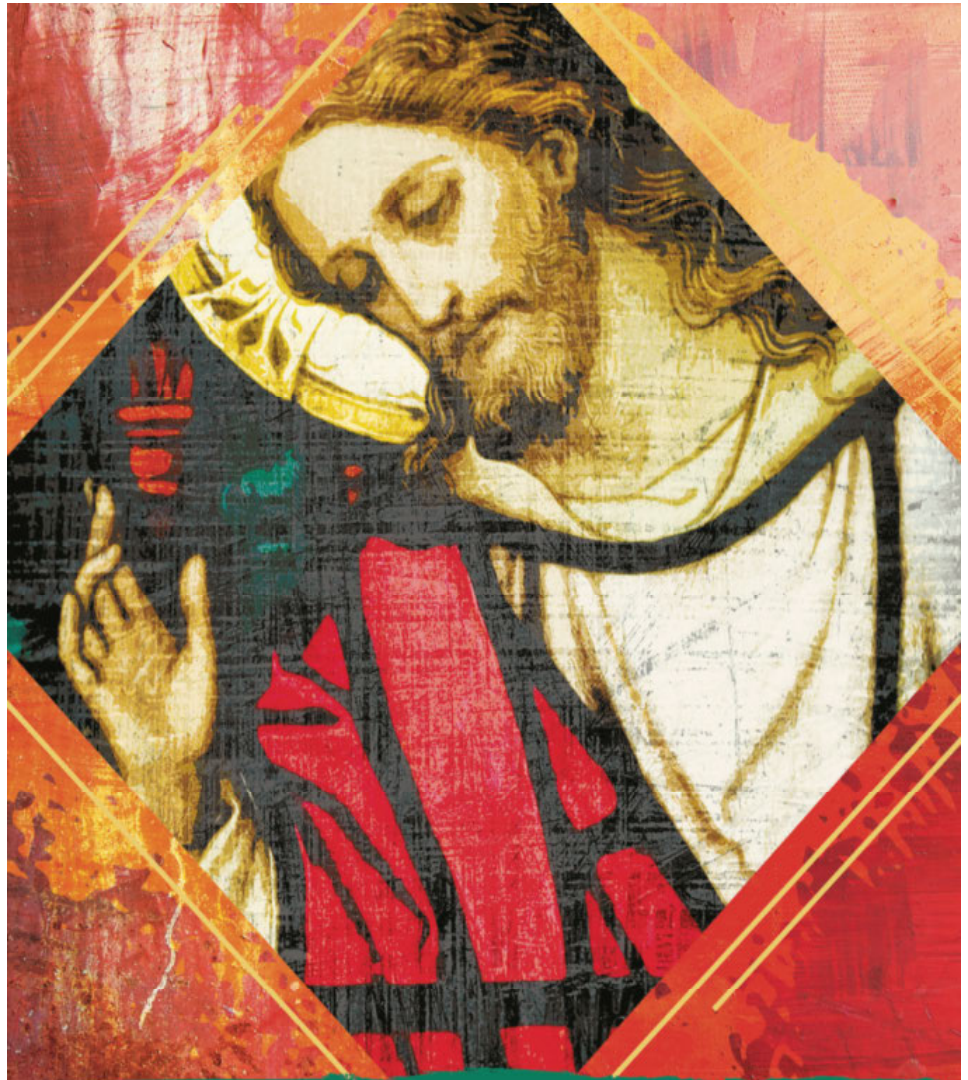

Catechists (Christian Formation Teachers) and Assistants Needed

Catechists are the backbone of our faith formation programs, so calling forth and retaining catechists is a top priority for St. John and St. Kilian. Calling catechists who are evangelizers, who see themselves as such, is one key to a successful faith formation process that forms disciples ~ the goal of a formation program. We **call** people to live out a **vocation!** Serving as a catechist is more than simple volunteerism. It is more than performing a function. It is more than filling a slot. It is a vocation: a call from God to serve His Church! St. John and St. Kilian are calling catechists for our formation programs. Let us share with you five aspects of the process of recruiting and retaining catechists who evangelize, using the word **"GIFTS"**:

G—Genuine
I—Inspiring
F—Formational
T—Trusting
S—Supporting

Genuine

Pope Paul VI, in *Evangelii Nuntiandi*, remarked, "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, or if he or she listens to teachers, he does so because they are witnesses." We are looking for catechists who are first disciples and exhibit a genuine, authentic spirit about their faith.

Inspiring

The "who" of our faith (Jesus Christ) is the reason behind our faith formation sessions. An evangelizing catechetical program inspires our children and youth to grow in relationship with Jesus Christ and His body, the Church. "What we especially need in these times are credible witnesses who make the Gospel visible by their lives as well as by their words, and who reawaken the attraction for Jesus Christ, for the beauty of God," says Pope Francis.

Formational

Our program seeks to help form catechists into disciples more than just teachers which is tremendously important. We strive to treat our team of catechists like a small Christian community to help them grow in faith together so that they can pass along their faith to others.

Trusting

There is an expression that all relationships move "at the speed of trust". Our efforts at forming disciples will only be fruitful if our catechists are able to show their groups that they know the information, but also that they care for and about those in their groups. The children and youth will only really learn and retain information from catechists if the catechists show them how much they care!

Supporting

We will provide ongoing support to our catechists individually and as a team. Building relationships that last is a key to catechists who are successful and confident with their groups. When catechists feel supported, it is natural that they will model that support for those in their groups and help them become disciples of Christ.

Please consider how you might answer the call to be disciple of Jesus by sharing your faith with our parish children and teens.
