### Mass Intentions

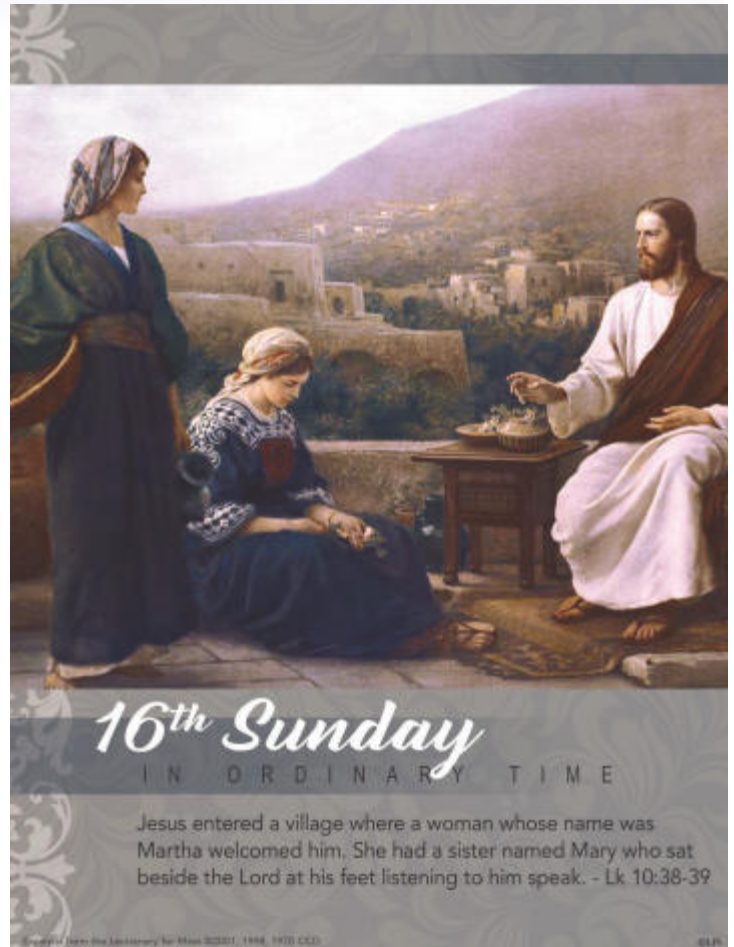

**WORDS FROM FATHER.....** Dear brothers and sisters, we all have had the experience of being overburdened by the many demands and responsibilities in life, as well as the uncertain future. Some of us may have had that one time when we just could not endure anymore and broke down. Or some of us had the moment – or moments – when we had trouble going to sleep because all our worries were keeping us awake. As we look back at those times and as we contemplate this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus' words stand out, "You are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." Ordinary life in the twenty-first century is a spiderweb of many things: family, job, taxes, news and politics, community and so on. Our ancestors had limited access to the world and could thus, live a focused life. However, in our world the internet has opened many doors to countless issues, topics and fields that constantly keep us on the go. And while our ancestors could focus on one profession, we on the other hand, have to be an expert in many different fields if, in the world's opinion, we want to keep our head above water. There is a modern-day advice in regard to the many worries and anxieties that we have to deal with, and it is basically that we have to "pick our battles." In other words, some modern gurus say that we can't be perfect with every-thing. And it is therefore better to pick out the things that are of value to us (things that are worth stressing about) and focus on them rather than get lost in the many challenges. This viewpoint seems to roughly fit in with Jesus' teaching this Sunday, especially with how one can be "worried about many things" when in reality "there is need of only one thing." Thus, on one hand, we should ask ourselves when in prayer and contemplation, "what is the one thing that I need?" "What is something that is worth toiling for?" "What is the one thing that Christ calls me to?" But more importantly we should also give heed to the other words of the same Christ, "Do not worry about your life...Look at the birds in the sky; they do not sow or reap, they gather nothing into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are not you more important than they? Can any of you by worrying add a single moment to your lifespan? (Matthew 6:25-27)" **Father Chahm**


