### Mass Intentions

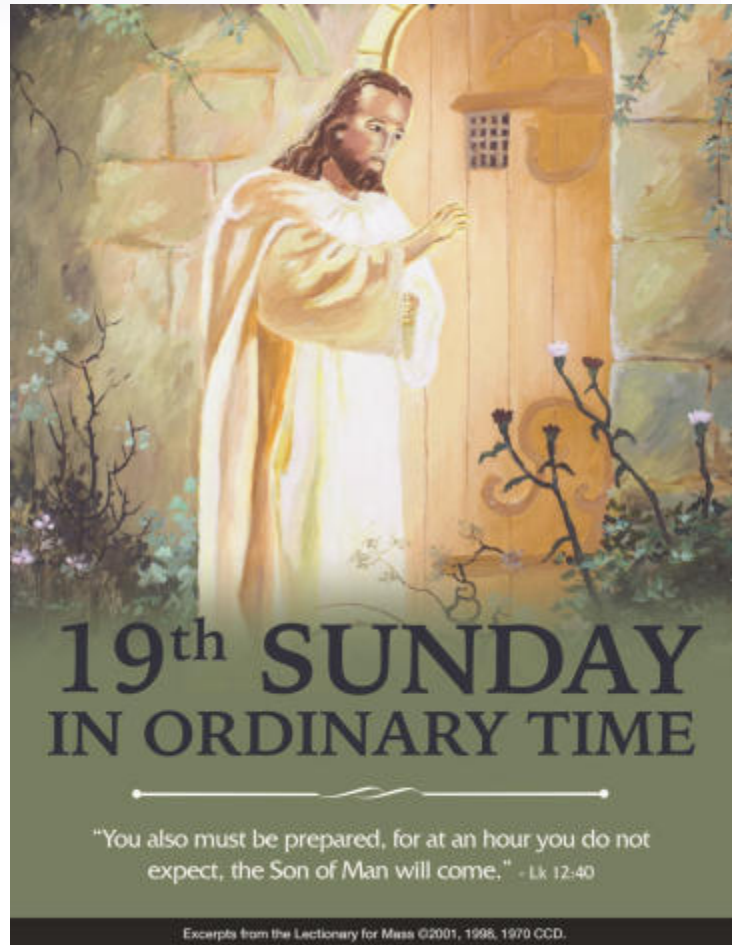

**WORDS FROM FATHER.....** Dear brothers and sisters, as we reflect on this Sunday's Gospel message, Jesus' words cannot be anymore clearer: He urges us to be vigilant while awaiting the master's return. For us who live in the time after the Ascension in which Jesus returned to Heaven, this means that we must be ever watchful for the return of Christ. But it is also a message to never grow weary of anticipating the coming of the Kingdom of God. On the other hand, though, while Christ's teaching applies to everyone, He especially emphasizes the duty of His disciples as He says, "much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more." The disciples of Christ have been entrusted with the authority to both proclaim the coming of Christ and nourish God's flock. In this sense, they are like the servant in this Sunday's parable who the master has put in charge of his household while he is gone. This responsibility passes on to the bishops of the Catholic Church since they are the spiritual descendants of Jesus' apostles. However, proclaiming the truth and looking after the people of the Church has never been an easy task. It takes courage, but more importantly it takes faith and trust in God to accomplish this calling. And further, the leaders of the Church are encouraged by the support of God's people. And therefore, although the scandals of people who held authority in the Church may still be fresh in our minds, let us not neglect to pray and help the good shepherds that are out there. At the same time, we know that even though all of us may not be clergy, the laity also have been given the role of priest, prophet and king to look after and raise in the faith those who we are called to look after. So keeping in mind that Jesus' message applies to all of us, and just as we share the one bread of the Body of Christ, let us fervently pray that Christ may strengthen all of us to remain faithful and watchful for the return of our Lord. **Father Chahm**
