Mass Intentions

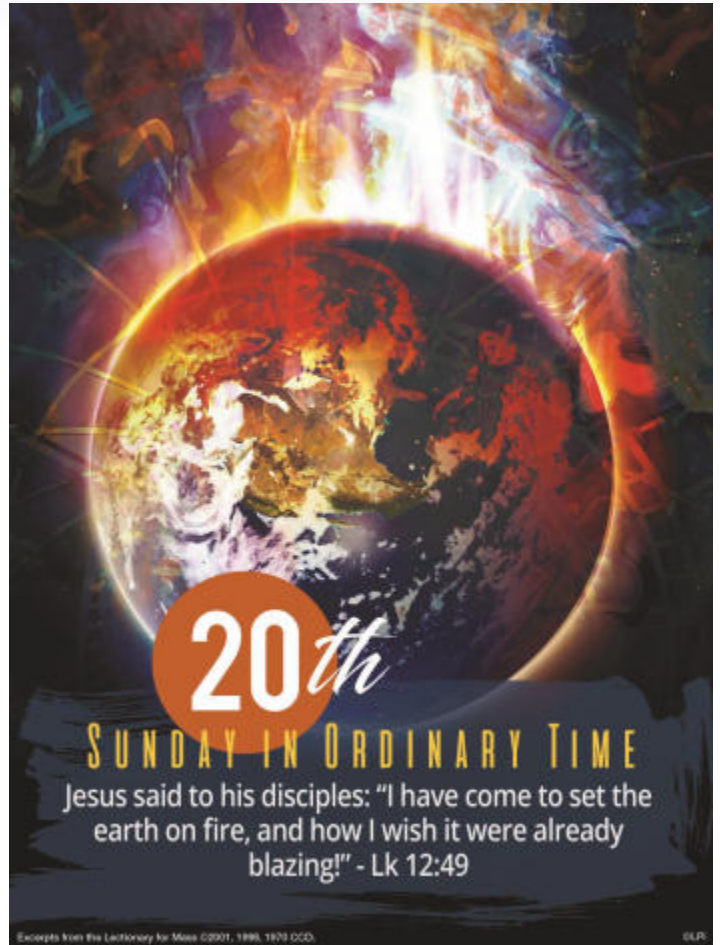

WORDS FROM FATHER.... Dear brothers and sisters,
 have you ever had a troublesome classmate, coworker, or even
 family member? And have you ever had the experience where this
 individual's misbehaviors would only continue to grow because the
 teacher, boss, or parent would do nothing about it? We probably
 have all been there in some time in life. Confronting someone or
 some group about something that they are doing wrong, or simply
 put, confrontation is never an easy task. However, it is a task that
 must be carried out. Otherwise, we risk the decay of our society as
 well as our own lives and the lives of those we love and care.
 To address a problem is even more difficult in our world today
 because our culture prefers to avoid confrontation so much that we
 are now at the point where we turn a blind eye toward problems
 that are so obvious. Ignorance and denial not only cause issues and
 selfish individuals to go rampant, but it also does great damage to
 ourselves. Because it is through confrontation, it is through facing
 our problems and fears, that we are able to grow and mature. If we
 only choose to run and hide throughout our life, we miss the
 opportunity to harden our skin and to form our identity. And we

 believe in. Jesus Christ speaks of bringing division this weekend.

 now defined by justice, faith, and righteousness - we then not only
 embody these noble values, but they also build up who we are.

 the more we join Christ with His cross, the more He will build us


