Mass Intentions

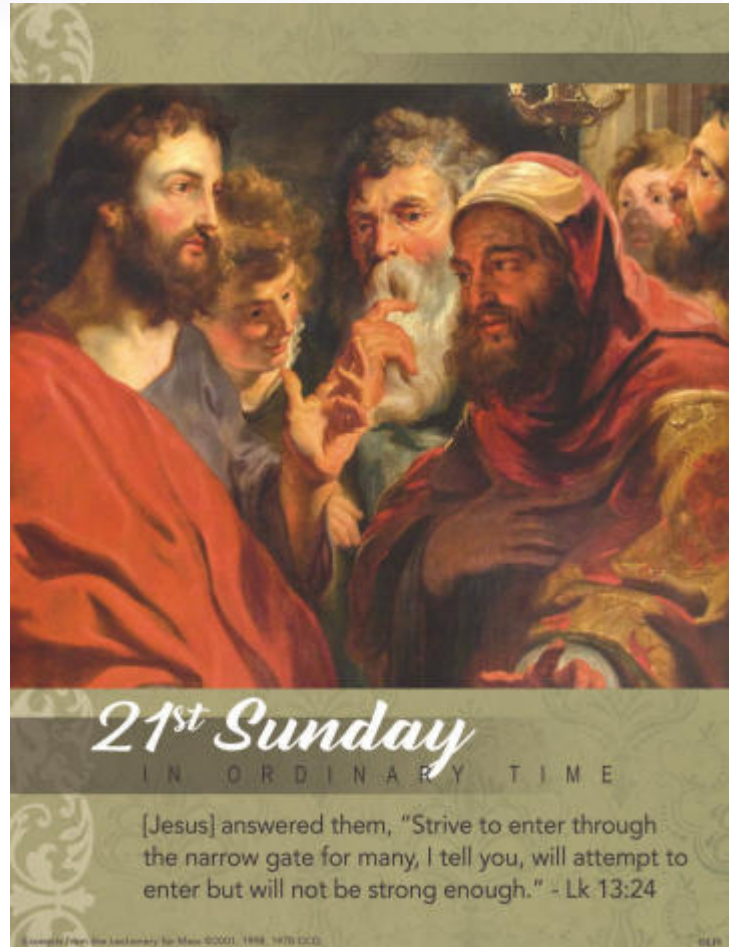

WORDS FROM FATHER.... Dear brothers and sisters,
 we sometimes find ourselves looking back to when we were young and
 miss those days of the past. And there are those past times that we prefer
 not to recall. For myself, it is bitter to remember the intense competition
 in a South Korean high school especially its academics. The regular
 bedtime hour would be past midnight because we would be reviewing our
 notes or studying. And even the closest friendships would be tested when
 trying to get first place in class. It would even be difficult to call up your
 buddies to go out and play because seven out of ten of your classmates
 would be at cram schools or have private tutoring. And the remaining
 three who were available were guys who had already given up the rat race.
 Why all the toiling? It was so that we could enter into a "good college",
 but further, so that we could pave out a better future life for ourselves.
 Certainly, looking back with a better understanding of reality, we can all
 agree that just because one gets good grades doesn't mean that they are
 necessarily winners in life. Yet oddly, one cannot help but have a
 nostalgia for all the competition and hard work of those high school
 years. And there is always some kind of regret of not giving our one
 hundred percent, "if only I had studied a bit harder" "if only I had not
 given up so quickly." Maybe one reason for this longing is because
 regardless of the outcome, one's hard work and suffering is what builds
 up who we are. Further, despite how much we hated the competition and
 the harsh educational system, it was this hardship that really made us
 internally strong as long as we kept on trying. It is even strange to realize
 that one even longs for that ruthless competition. Perhaps it's because it
 was the one true thing that boiled our spirits and disciplined us into
 maturity. Nowadays, we have a grave misunderstanding that entering into
 Heaven is free pass. But if the gates to God's Kingdom is wide open can
 we really say that it's worth it? If entry into the Kingdom requires no kind
 of sacrifice or discipline what good can it be? That is why one is firmly
 convinced that indeed Heaven's entrance is a narrow one that requires
 discipline and hard work in this present life. And Jesus confirms this as
 He strongly tells us to "strive to enter through the narrow gate...(many)
 will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough." In addition, the
 author of the Letter to the Hebrews encourages his readers, "My son, do
 not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by
 him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines." So instead of rolling our
 eyes when we hear the harsh words of Christ this weekend, let us accept it
 as an "tough pep talk" and let us remind our hearts that by devoting
 ourselves to the life of Christ, and by standing up for the truth, we are
 forging ourselves into children of God. **Father Chahm**


