### Mass Intentions

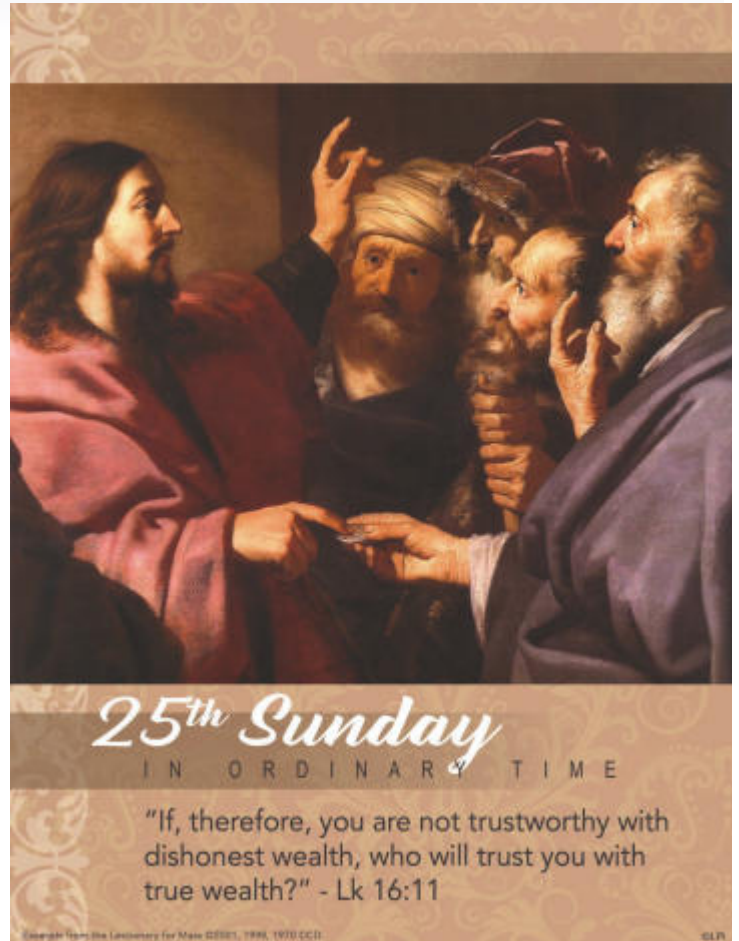

**WORDS FROM FATHER....** Dear brothers and sisters,  
 this Sunday we come across a difficult and puzzling parable which  
 is the parable of the Shrewd steward. A steward who had been  
 caught squandering his master's wealth is about to be fired.  
 The steward then gets in touch with the master's debtors and  
 forges documents so that the debtors owe less. By doing this the  
 steward now has friends who he can rely on when he is  
 unemployed. In the end, the master finds out about this but  
 commends the steward for acting prudently. Here, the parable is  
 not praising the dishonestly of the shrewd steward. Rather, refer-  
 ring to the biblical exegesis of George Martin, the master is  
 commending the steward for "reacting prudently in a time of  
 crisis." In other words, the steward's foresight and decisive action is  
 what is being highlighted here. Then Jesus goes on to say, "Make  
 friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so when it fails, you  
 will be welcomed into eternal dwellings." What Jesus is saying is,  
 "make friends for yourselves by the use of your money. So that  
 when money fails (since money is corrupt) you will be welcomed  
 into eternal dwellings." We know well that Jesus always urged His  
 disciples to use their possessions and money to help the poor and  
 those in need. Therefore, by using money wisely, which is using it  
 to help those in need, we will be welcomed into God's Kingdom.  
 On that note, brothers and sisters, I would like to let you know  
 that this weekend we will be having a special collection to help the  
 victims in the Bahamas and the Southeast of the United States  
 who have been affected by Hurricane Dorian. Our Bishop Donald  
 Hying has also explained that this charity is a Corporal Work of  
 Mercy. By assisting those who are in desperate need, the Holy  
 Spirit will make clear our path to God's Kingdom. **Father Chahm**

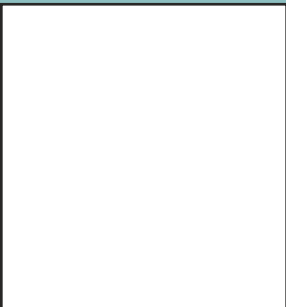
