

A week from this Saturday (that is, on Saturday September 11 at 7:00 pm until 8:30 pm), Holy Family will be hosting an exciting event called ARISE. This article will be published in the St. Robert bulletin as well - and I hope parishioners from both parishes can be supportive and excited about this event. You have probably heard it announced at Masses and advertised in the bulletin over the preceding weeks and months. I hope that many of our parishioners can come. This evening is especially good for those who have been away, and for those who have friends who have been away from the faith and/or are not Catholic.

Why? Because it is what ARISE is made for! Although I always hope people will invite their friends to Mass, the Mass can be a difficult thing for someone to come to as a "first" experience of the Catholic Church. Several years back, a parishioner came to me upset that we did not allow people to bring food and coffee to Mass, saying that if we allowed food and drink in the pews, people would be more welcomed. Additionally, she was upset that we encourage quiet after and before Mass for people to pray. She said that greeting people was her favorite thing to do. I asked her when is the last time she spoke to someone new after Mass, and she could not remember. It turned out she never welcomed anyone, but just wanted to catch up with her friends. Sometimes people like that can do the opposite - by talking to everyone but the people they don't know, people come to our Churches and feel less welcome than if people had stayed to simply pray. Most of us don't speak with strangers on Sunday, and I don't know if I have ever witnessed someone seeing a stranger, sitting with them, explaining the parts of the Mass to them during the service. (Although I imagine there may be some of you who are reading this who have done it, It is a rare exception). I actually don't think that the Mass is the best "first experience" of the Church. Furthermore, people cannot fully participate in the Mass in the Eucharist until they are fully initiated.

ARISE can help fill that gap. It is an evening of great contemporary music featuring the ARISE band, and powerful testimony from Fr. Luke Strand, all in the context of Eucharistic Adoration, and hospitality geared to those who are new, those who have been away, and those looking to encounter Jesus in a new or deeper way. Because it is not Mass, people in the pews can participate fully in song, praise, and their own private prayer regardless of their faith. For those who have been away for a while, priests from all over will be present for Confession in the NEWLY remodeled confessionals! A special thanks to those who contributed last year for that project. (For St. Robert Parishioners reading this, I'll begin working on the St. Robert confessionals this September).

Let's represent our parishes and our cities well on September 11th by coming to ARISE at Holy Family at 7:00 pm until 8:30 pm, bringing our friends, our coworkers, our children (this is a VERY kid friendly event), and be a warm welcoming smile to those who are visiting our parish for the first time!
