





In preparation for World Marriage Day on Sunday, February 13th, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops asks us to pray and reflect on the beauty of the Sacrament of Marriage during National Marriage Week (February 7-14). The whole week is an opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family. The theme for 2022 is "Called to the Joy of Love."

World Marriage Day (WMD) honors husband and wife as the foundation of the family, the basic unit of society. It salutes the beauty of their faithfulness, sacrifice, and joy in daily married life.

History. The idea of celebrating marriage began in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, in 1981, when couples encouraged the mayor, the governor, and the Bishop to proclaim Saint Valentine's Day as "We Believe in Marriage Day." The event was so successful, the idea was presented to and adopted by Worldwide Marriage Encounter's National Leadership. By 1982, 43 governors officially proclaimed the day, and celebrations spread to U.S.

military bases in several foreign countries. In 1983, the name was changed to "World Marriage Day," designated to be celebrated each year on the second Sunday in February. In 1993, his Holiness, Pope John Paul II, imparted his Apostolic Blessings on World Marriage Day (WMD). WMD celebrations continue to grow and spread to more countries and faith expressions every year.

All Catholic married couples deserve an extraordinary marriage according to God's design. Extraordinary marriages exhibit many important qualities – joy in each other's company, mutual respect, outward displays of affection, and so many other obvious signs of the shared life of the couple – when two become one flesh.

Married couples cooperate with God's grace to make their marriage strong when they avail themselves of the sacraments, seek help in dealing with serious issues, and make the marital relationship a priority. Learning and practicing strategies for increased marital intimacy is an important part of the daily, lifelong work of marriage. The Sacrament of Marriage itself is a journey that is meant to bring the spouses closer to God and each other on the path to their ultimate destiny – heaven.
