



We have much to celebrate! The school just held a very successful Open House at the end of January and we enjoyed a week-long celebration of Catholic Schools Week. It was a time of traditions, recognition, community, Masses, and of course, continued learning. Thank you for all you do as a parishioner to support Catholic education right here at HF.

This weekend we are celebrating our largest fundraiser of the year - the HF Auction and Dinner Dance. It is sure to be a great event, supporting an even greater cause, and filled with current families, alumni families, and parishioners alike. I am thankful to our hard-working

Students are enjoying many field trips this year to enhance their learning.
