
PARISH NEWS AND NOTES

Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. Following the example of the Ninevites, who did penance in sackcloth and ashes, our foreheads are marked with ashes to humble our hearts and remind us that life passes away on Earth. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us. As the priest, deacon or minister applies the ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the

words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." or "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

The ashes are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year. The ashes are blessed with Holy Water by the priest on Ash Wednesday. While the ashes symbolize penance and contrition, they are also a reminder that God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts. His Divine mercy is of utmost importance during the season of Lent, and the Church calls on us to seek that mercy during the entire Lenten season with reflection, prayer and penance.

Ashes are a symbol of penance made sacramental by the blessing of the Church, and they help us develop a spirit of humility and sacrifice.

May this Lent may be a blessing to all of you!

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent. Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On those days they should eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday. Individuals suffering from chronic illnesses and pregnant or nursing women are excused from the obligation to fast.
