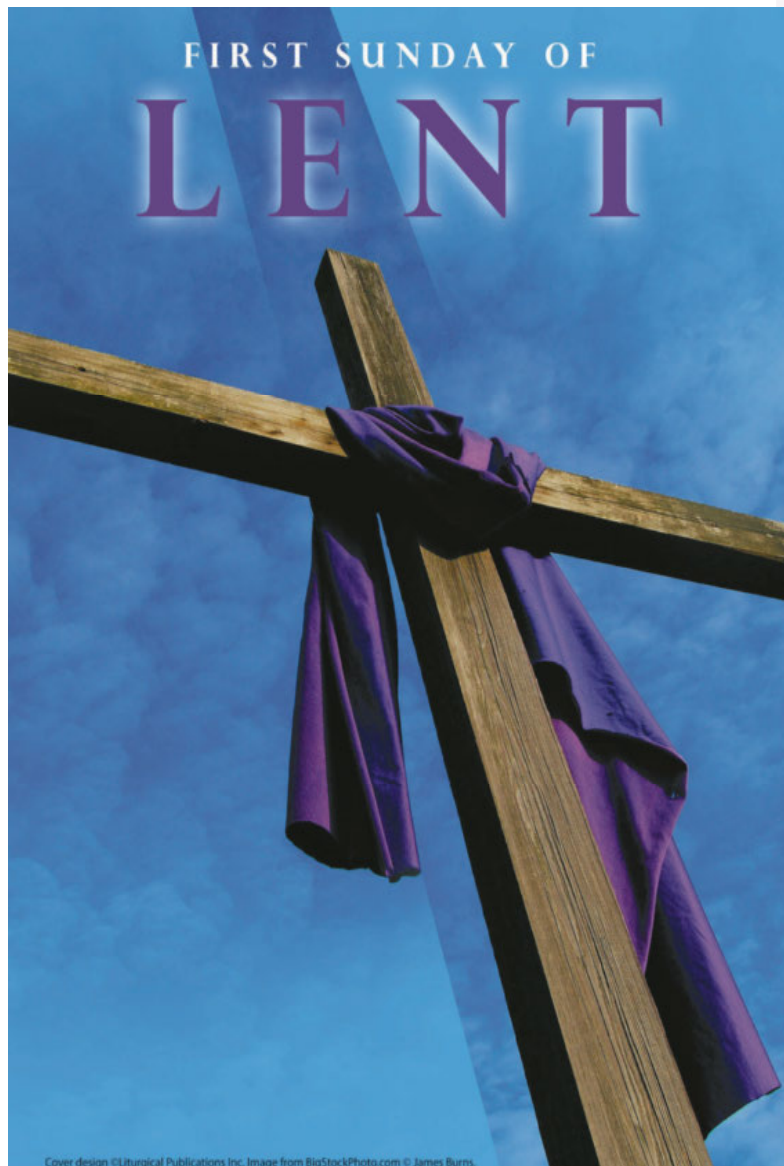

PARISH NEWS AND NOTES

- **Pantry Donations Needed** - Food Pantry needs in Milwaukee are great. Please continue to bring your donations of non-perishable foods to weekend Masses. Volunteers deliver them to local food pantries each week.
- **Hygiene Collection** - During Lent, the Holy Family Parish School and Religious Education Program are once again teaming up to collect hygiene items for the House of Peace. Collection boxes are located in the back of the church as well as in the school lobby. Items to be collected include: soap, body wash, dish soap, shampoo/conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush & floss, deodorant, lip balm, razors, hand sanitizer, feminine sanitary products, facial tissues, toilet paper roll, washcloth/baby wipes, hand/body lotion
- **Spiritual Adoption** - By the sixth month of pregnancy, unborn babies respond to sound and have a good chance of survival if born at this time. Keep praying! "Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted, who is in danger of abortion."

Dear Holy Family Parishioners,

In the Summer of 2018, I had just graduated from UWM and was looking for my next step in life. I applied to be Parish Life Coordinator at St. Robert because I had a passion for the Catholic faith and was excited about the opportunity to turn that passion into a career. It didn't take long to realize that I had stumbled upon an incredibly blessed role within the community. In this capacity she will oversee existing programs such as small groups, registration and welcoming of new parishioners, produce the newsletter, and provide support to parish ministries to encourage faith formation and community building events. 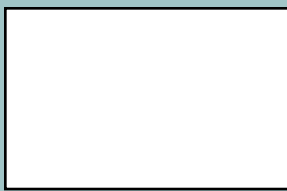
Like to bake? Dessert donations are needed each week and can be dropped off in McCormick Hall after 12 noon on fish fry Fridays.

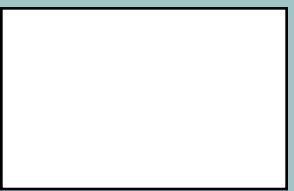
