

Dear Holy Family Parishioners,

In the Summer of 2018, I had just graduated from UWM and was looking for my next step in life. I applied to be Parish Life Coordinator at St. Robert because I had a passion for the Catholic faith and was excited about the opportunity to turn that passion into a career. It didn't take long to realize that I had stumbled upon an incredibly blessed role within the community. Over the past four and a half years, I've gotten to know so many kind and generous parishioners and families, and watch the parish grow in number and faith.

A year into working part-time in Parish Life, I accepted another part-time position of Youth Ministry Coordinator for both St. Robert and Holy Family. In this capacity she will oversee existing programs such as small groups, registration and welcoming of new parishioners, produce the newsletter, and provide support to parish ministries to encourage faith formation and community building events. 
