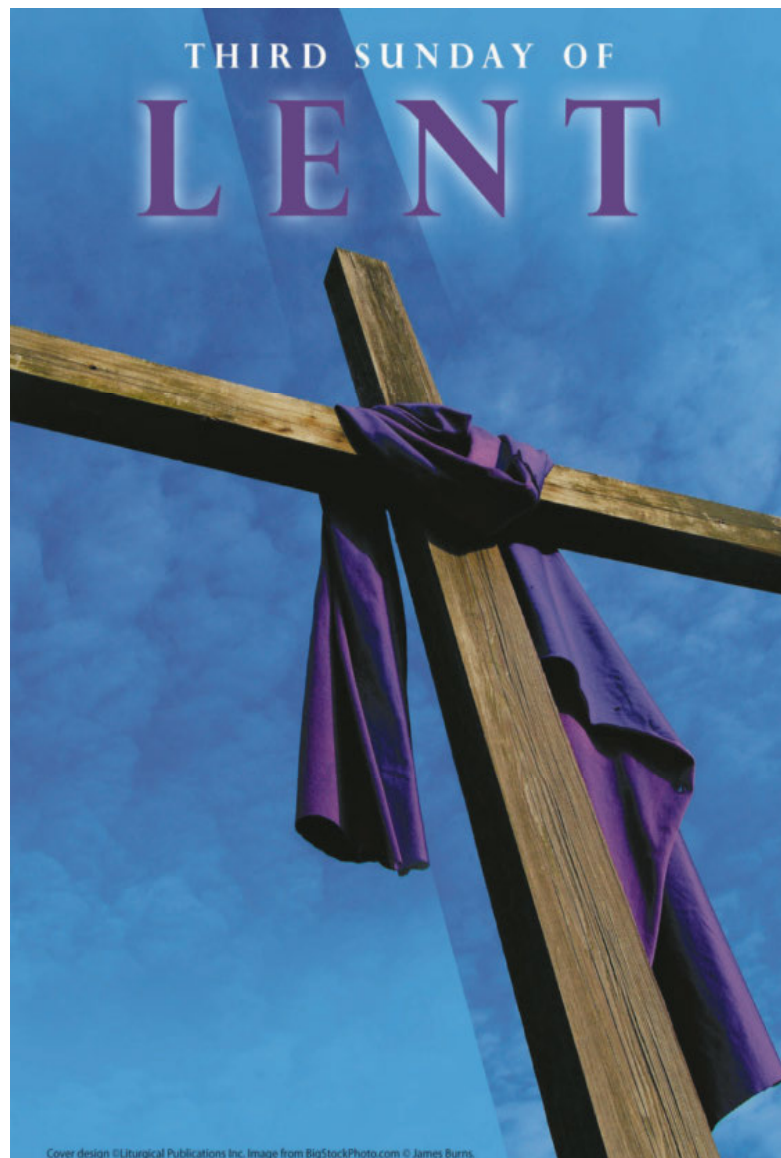

PARISH NEWS AND NOTES

- **Youth Ministry Pancake Breakfast** - Sunday, March 19th in McCormick Hall - 9:00 am to noon. Proceeds will be used for the youth summer trip.
- **Hygiene Collection** - During Lent, our parish school, grade school Religious Education, and high school Youth Ministry are once again teaming up to collect hygiene items for the House of Peace. Collection boxes are located in the back of the church as well as in the school lobby. Items to be collected include: soap, body wash, dish soap, shampoo/conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush & floss, deodorant, lip balm, razors, hand sanitizer, feminine sanitary products, facial tissues, toilet paper roll, washcloth/baby wipes, hand/body lotion
- **Pantry Donations Needed** - As government food benefits are being reduced, your donations of non-perishable items are greatly needed. Food from Holy Family parishioners is donated to local pantries each week.
- **Spiritual Adoption** - Let's pray that the right to life of all children, no matter the circumstances of their conception, be respected Check out this message from Rebecca Kiessling, an attorney who was conceived through rape: www.4life4family.org/abortion-rape/. *"Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted, who is in danger of abortion."*
- **Stations of the Cross** - Please join us in the church for Stations of the Cross at 5:45pm every Friday in Lent.
- **Dispensation for St. Patrick's Day** - After careful consideration, Archbishop ListECKI has granted a dispensation for March 17th which lifts the obligation of abstinence from meat on Fridays during Lent so Catholics in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee can celebrate St. Patrick's Day. Catholics who partake in the St. Patrick's Day feast are encouraged to engage in another sacrificial or charitable act that day or give up meat on another day.
- **RCIA News** - The RCIA will be praying Scrutiny Rites at Holy Family at the 10:30am Mass this Sunday and on Sunday, March 26. Please join us as we pray for the RCIA participants and ourselves, as we uncover all that is defective in our hearts, and strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.
- **Baby Items Wanted** - The Milwaukee Chapter of the Christ Child Society needs new size 3-6 month pajamas, crib blankets, receiving blankets, sweater sets, blanket sleepers, bottles, socks, onesies, diapers and baby books. Happy Lent Holy Family,

Holy Family School is celebrating Lent in many different ways. Each Wednesday after Mass, the students and teachers will be praying a decade of the rosary together. We are collecting hygiene items to be donated to the House of Peace. On Ash Wednesday students participated in a rice bowl lunch as a form of fasting and also to partake in the Catholic Social Teaching of Solidarity of the Human Family. We are called to work for social justice throughout the world. Our human family includes people of all racial, cultural and religious backgrounds. At lunch we were one universal family under Christ by eating rice like many people do around the world. When we share a common meal, we are not only sharing the

experience of eating rice but also the experience of having a simple meal with only those close to us and having our basic needs met. It was a quiet lunch of reflection - a beautiful way to begin Lent.

As we start to look toward spring, I would like to let you know about two scholarship opportunities that are available to you as parishioners:

Holy Family School Scholarship

Scholarship money is available to families that are attending or interested in attending Holy Family School. To be eligible, families must be active members of our parish and school, in financial need, and display good character. There is an application process and the deadline has been extended to April 14, 2023.

Catholic High School Scholarship

When our former pastor, Father Tom Kerstein, passed away in 1998, he and his family left money to Holy Family to fund scholarships for Holy Family Parish School graduates to attend Catholic high schools. To be eligible, students must be active members of our parish, attending or planning on attending a Catholic high school, in good academic standing, in financial need and display good character. Applications will now be accepted through April 14, 2023.

It is my goal, as well as the goal of our Scholarship Committee, to help ensure that our extraordinary Catholic education is available and accessible. Applications can be found on the website or can be picked up in the school or parish office. Please feel free to contact myself or Elizabeth Cleveland with questions or comments.

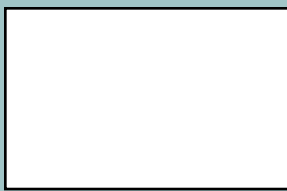
Fish Fry News

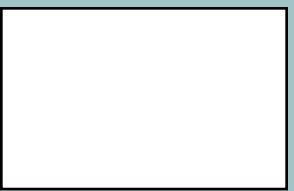
