

- Fish Fry News If you haven't had a chance to join us for a Lenten fish fry, please don't miss out! We're so grateful for all the support! Desserts can be dropped off in McCormick Hall after noon on Fridays. Thanks!
- Holy Hour Deacon Mike Dunn presides at a Holy Hour in the church at 6:30pm every Monday. The Hour includes Adoration, Evening Vespers, and the Rosary. All are welcome!
- Hygiene Collection During Lent, our parish school, grade school Religious Education, and high school Youth Ministry are once again teaming up to collect hygiene items for the House of Peace. Collection boxes are located in the back of the church as well as in the school lobby. Items to be collected include: soap, body wash, dish soap, shampoo/conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush & floss, deodorant, lip balm, razors, hand sanitizer, feminine sanitary products, facial tissues, toilet paper roll, washcloth/baby wipes, hand/body lotion.

This week we're praying for the Larson family

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA, is the process through which persons of catechetical age who have never been baptized, those already baptized in another Christian tradition, as well adults who have been baptized as Catholics but who have not been confirmed or received the Eucharist; can respond to God's loving invitation to conversion and Christian discipleship by preparing for initiation into the Catholic Church. Through prayer, study, and interaction with a particular parish highlighted by participation in a series of liturgical rites celebrated within that parish community – the RCIA process helps catechumens and candidates to grow in faith and the love of Christ as they begin to experience what it means to live as Catholic Christian disciples of Jesus.

### Who is a catechumen?

Those never baptized undergo a period of catechetical preparation and spiritual formation, after which they may become catechumens. During their time as

catechumens, they deepen their understanding of the faith in order to ready themselves for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. The Rite of Election is the ritual that marks their entry into the final phase of their preparation to receive the sacraments of initiation, at the Easter Vigil. Following the Rite of Election, they are called "the elect," since they have been elected by the Church in the person of the Archbishop to become members.

#### Who is a candidate?

In addition, those already validly baptized in a different Christian tradition (such as Lutheran or Methodist) who experience a call to become Catholic are called candidates for reception into the full communion of the Catholic Church. By virtue of their baptism, they are already adopted children of God, brothers or sisters within our Catholic family. In order to become Catholic they must complete their initiation through a profession of faith, followed by reception of the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist. During Lent, these candidates are invited to join the elect in their final period of preparation for these sacraments of initiation, which are normally celebrated at Easter.

#### The Rite of Election in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee

On February 26, the First Sunday of Lent, I had the privilege to be present and accompany our brothers and sisters to the Cathedral to celebrate the Rite of Election (for the catechumens) which was celebrated jointly with the Call to Continuing Conversion (for the candidates). Then, throughout the remainder of Lent – which focuses on the need for ongoing conversion – the elect and candidates join with Catholics throughout the world in seeking to deepen their faith, grow in holiness, and strengthen their relationships with God and neighbor.

It was very uplifting to see the Cathedral full of people seeking to become Catholic! Let us pray for them, that we as their brothers and sisters may continue to build the Kingdom of God together!




