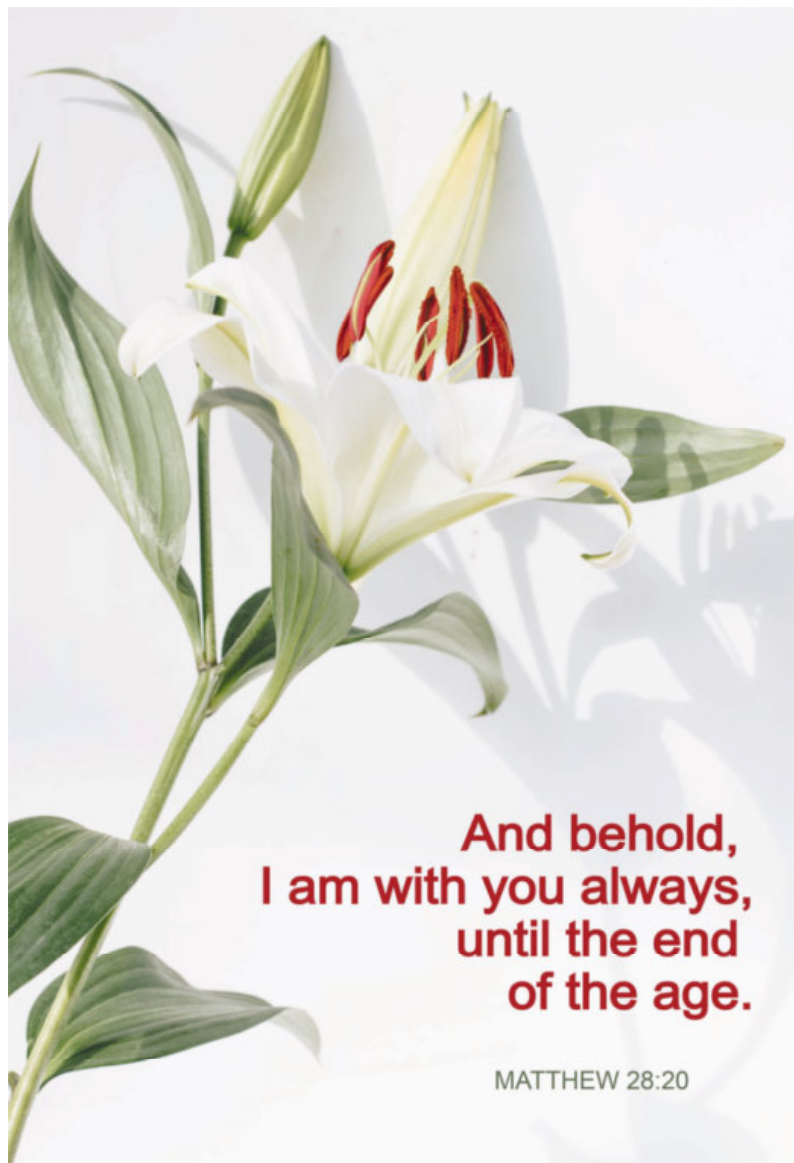

Hola!

Today we celebrate the Ascension of Jesus to Heaven after the Resurrection.

The first thing to remember about the Ascension is that it is about sharing in Jesus' joy. It is about celebrating his return to the heavenly glory. It is about rejoicing that his crown of thorns has been replaced with the kingly crown, that the mocking crowd at Calvary has been replaced with myriads of adoring angels and saints. The Ascension is about Jesus' triumph and glorification.

The Ascension is a feast of hope. He goes to prepare a place for us *"In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be."* (John 14: 2-3) For us to be holy and faithful until the end, we need his divine power. That's another reason we ought to rejoice in his Ascension. He takes his place at God's right hand so that he can pour out the promise of the Father, the Holy Spirit, upon his disciples and upon all of us.

As he ascends, he tells the disciples to wait for this power. But this waiting is not passive. In fact, in Acts of the Apostles 1:11, after the Lord ascends out of their sight, the angels asked why the disciples just stand there, staring at the sky. Our waiting ought to be with purpose, praying and looking forward to the empowerment given by the Holy Spirit. Why empowerment? Because we have a challenging mission to do. *"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations."*

Everyday, more and more, I grow in the awareness that evangelization is not something that happened in mission countries far away, carried out by priests and religious. I have heard people telling me that mission countries are in Asia or Africa. But the reality is that our own neighborhoods are mission territory. The Lord has called Fr. Andrew and I to be missionaries in the missionary territory of Milwaukee, Shorewood, Whitefish Bay, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. However the Lord is not calling us to be the only missionaries, the Lord is not only calling the priests and religious to be missionaries, the Lord is calling you, yes YOU. Every single Catholic is called to be an evangelist.

Jesus, who was crucified has risen and has ascended to His father. This is the "good news" the Apostles are commissioned to spread - to the whole world, to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem - It's the good news we must spread today.

Do you feel inadequate to the task? Pray for the power of the Holy Spirit to move in and through you. Keep learning more about your faith so that you can share it with ever greater confidence. Remember, the chief evangelizer is the Holy Spirit himself, we are his instruments, so open up to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in prayer and he will guide you.

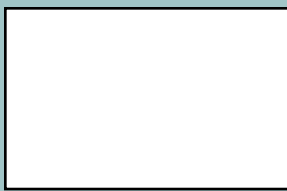

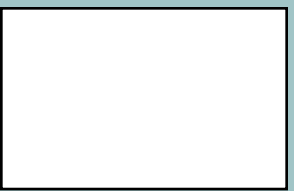
