### Annual Food Drive Kick-Off ~

On Monday, October 22nd, the Parish School students, CYF students, and families welcomed Brother Robert Wotypka, OFM Capuchin along with Mr. Mark Ulmen as we kicked-off our Annual Food Drive. Mr. Ulmen lead us in song while Brother Robert provided a presentation on the need for food during the holiday time and other services provided by the Capuchin Community Services. Brother Robert shared how many people they serve nightly at St. Ben's Meal. Roughly 350 meals distributed from 9th & State. People from all over the area that need a hot meal are free to come Sunday - Friday. Their services provide hot showers and clean undergarments daily to those in need. At the House of Peace where Brother Robert is the Pastoral Director, he explained the services available to those who live in zip code 53205 and 53233. An individual can receive 15 pounds of food per week and a family of 5 will receive 45 pounds of food per week. Brother Robert asked the students if that was a lot of food? As young as some of them are they too knew that wasn't a lot for one person or a family to live on. He also asked the students "I'm thinking of a word that starts with the letter "D" that Jesus calls us to do? What do you think it might be? Many answers were given ~ even one student answered "Disciple" though a very good response and yes Jesus does call each of us to be His Disciples...But no that wasn't it. He was looking for the word "Duty"! Saying that each of us has a duty to reach out to others in need, while quoting Matthew 5:3-10 Scripture on the 8 Beatitudes.

Brother Robert invited all students and families and anyone from St. Charles to attend their Housewarming for the St. Anthony Apartments on Saturday, November 17th located at 1004 N. 10th Street, Milwaukee. These Apartments were re-purposed using the former St. Anthony Hospital. 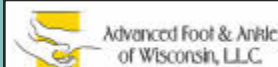
