St. Luke's Outreach to Distribute Communion needs your help.

On the 4th Sunday of every month St. Charles Borromeo has distributed communion to the hospitalized. We are asking St. Roman's Parish to join this outreach as a joint parish effort. To volunteer at St. Luke's

you will need to be set up as a volunteer at St. Luke's and the following items are required.

- Initial application done on line at www.aurora.org/volunteer.
- Forms completed: Statement of Confidential and Compliance Information, Patients Rights Statement, Health Information form, and TB Questionnaire
- Attendance at a 'New Volunteer Orientation' session. There are several of these each month at various locations across the metro area. You can attend any one of them regardless of where you'd actually like to serve. For example, one could attend orientation at West Allis Medical Center even though you'd like to serve here at St. Luke's.
- Provide Vaccination Information on: Mumps, measles and rubella (MMR) vaccination records, Flu vaccination record
- Background check processed by St. Luke's on volunteers 18 years of age or older

Once all the paperwork is processed you are given a tour of the facility and issued a badge with a volunteer number so that you can sign in on the days you volunteer.
