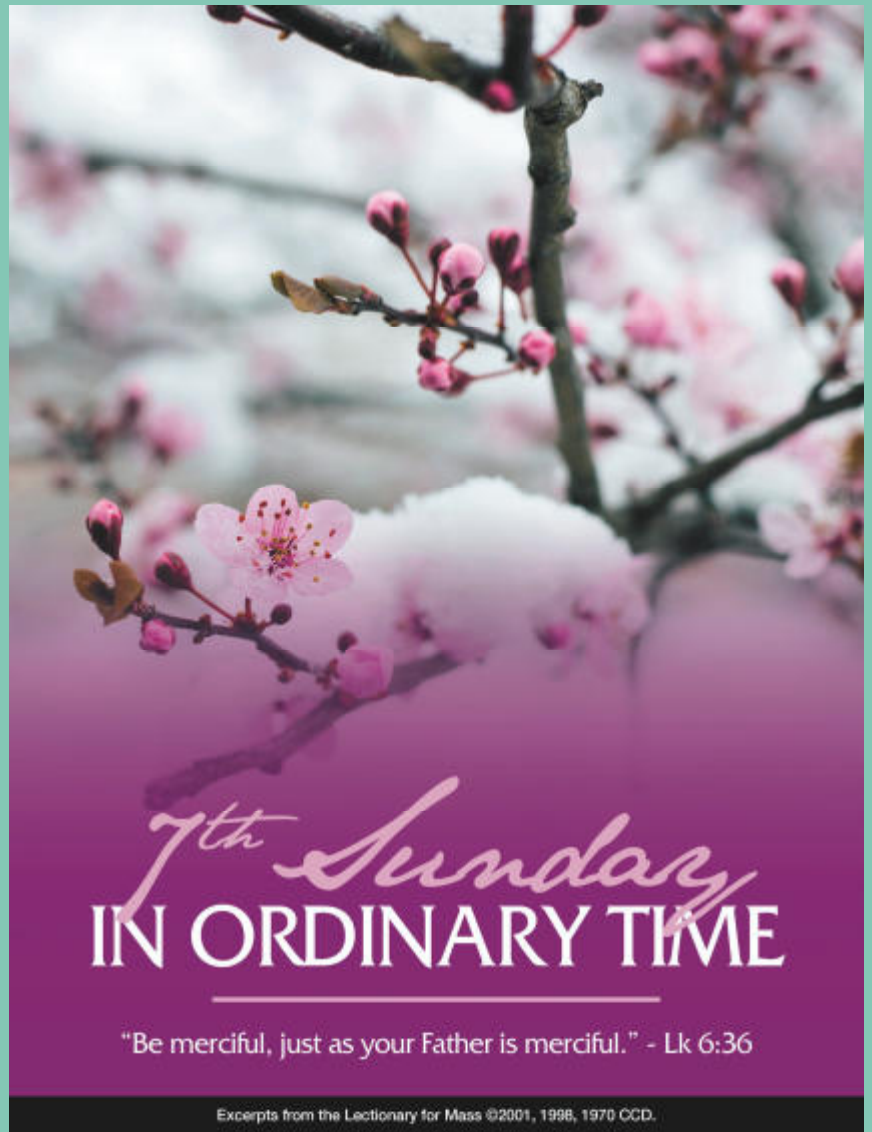

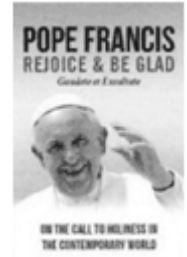
Happenings In and Outside The Parish

Lenten Round - Table Discussion Reflections

We will read the recent apostolic exhortation - papal pep-talk
from Pope Francis on holiness:

“Rejoice and Be Glad”

(IN LATIN GAUDETE ET EXULTATE)



The small book is short and inspiring,

- encouraging all in our destiny to be the best persons we can be,
- explaining what a saint is and isn't,
- reminding us that God calls each of us to be holy by our Baptism.

Francis also warns us of the dangers of two subtle enemies of holiness

- Gnosticism, in which the intellect is considered separate from and superior to the flesh and which judges people on their ability to understand complicated doctrines,
- and Pelagianism, which claims that all depends on our human will and not on God's mercy.

Francis encourages us to take the Beatitudes of Jesus as our human identity card,

- to recognize the signs of true holiness in today's world,
- to persevere in the Christian life in the face of opposing weaknesses and evils,
- to be vigilant and
- to use the grace of the Holy Spirit to discern the way God wants us to live in order to come to our full maturity as Christians.

In our reading this writing and considering it together, we hope to understand the true mission each of us has to be holy in our own unique circumstances and manner, and to encourage each other in our following of Christ.

A note from the St. Charles Stewardship Committee-

Over the last few weeks the staff has posted articles about different opportunities available in the parish to help serve the parish and the community.

Some parishioners have committed time to helping to keep our parish grounds beautiful, others have volunteered to help clean the church, these helped with reducing the costs for lawn care and cleaning services.

The parish office has volunteers that help stuff the monthly newsletters and other special mailings, money counters who help with the weekly donations, and bake for bake sales and other activities thru the year. Do you have a calling to help?
