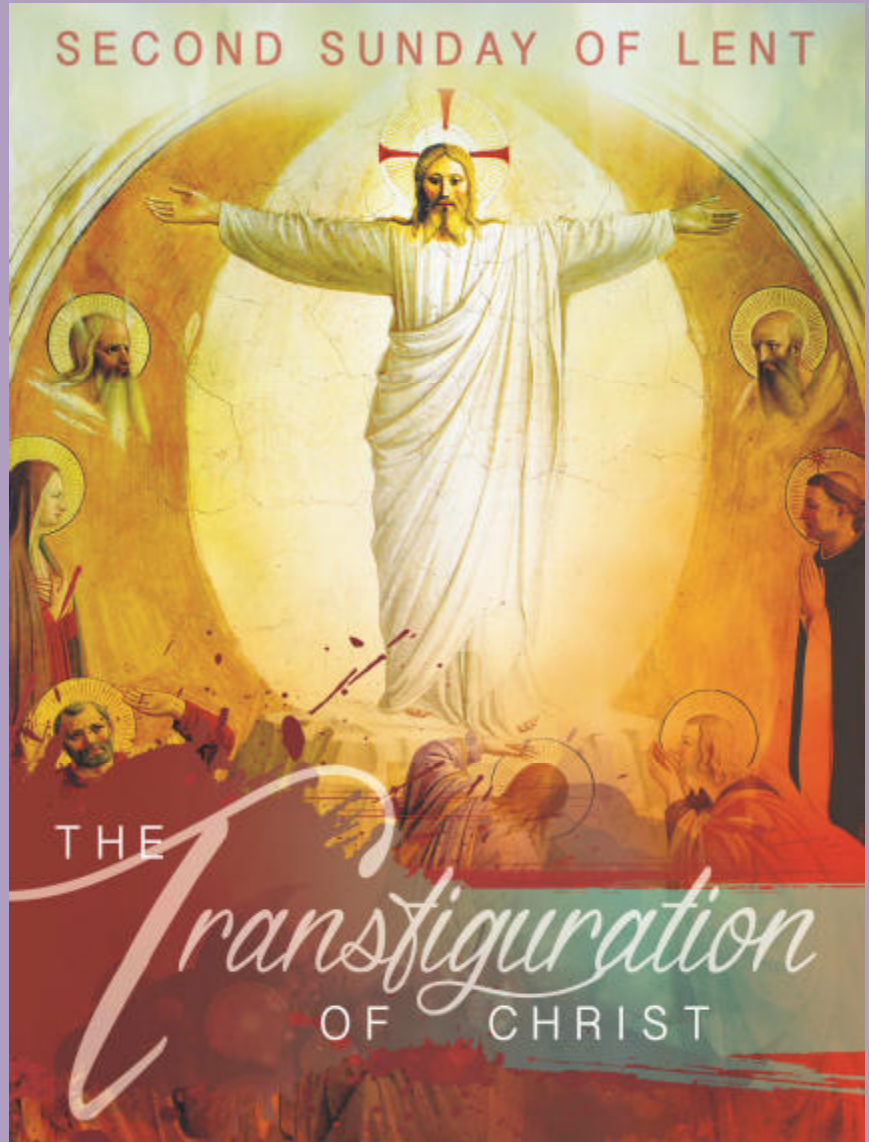

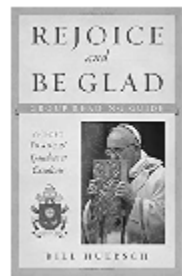
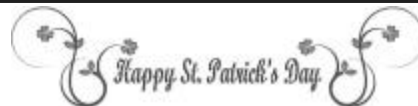

Parish and School News

On Saturday, March 9th, some of our High School students and Confirmation Candidates served at the Hunger Task Force putting together Stock Boxes for the elderly in and around Milwaukee County. These boxes help low income seniors fulfill a need so they do not have to choose between buying food or buying medication. In three hours, these youth and other volunteers packed 15 pallets (48 boxes on each pallet).



On Wednesday, we gathered as a community for Ash Wednesday Mass. We began this Mass with the annual burying of the Alleluia's. Each student decorated an alleluia banner and then, as they processed into church, dropped their Alleluia's into a wooden box. We then covered the wooden box with heavy rocks. We will resurrect the Alleluia's when we return after Easter. At Mass on Wednesday each child also received a Rice Bowl.



Sunday, March 10th six children from St. Roman Parish celebrated the Rite of Sending at the 10:30am Mass. Each child signed their name in the Book of the Elect. This Ritual is celebrated on the First Sunday of Lent across the Archdiocese. In effect the communities Send Forth children and adults that are in the process of preparing to be Initiated into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil on April 20th. Literally, right after Mass, we headed down to the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist where about one hundred other catechumens and candidates preparing for Initiation were greeted with a handshake from the Archbishop and welcomed to the "Mother Church" of the Archdiocese. He asked their sponsors if these new Elect were studying hard and are they willing to continue to journey with these Elect to the Table of the Lord. With a resounding "We Are" the Archbishop blessed them and sent them back to continue learning about Jesus and His Mission for each of us. Enjoy these pictures of the children signing the Book of the Elect, on the altar steps of the Cathedral, Betty Salazar introducing the children to the Archbishop.

This is another example of collaboration ~ thanks to our trained catechist Gina Andresen, the older children attend RCIA for Children classes at St. Charles on Monday evenings. Working together helps share resources and further builds the Kingdom of God.
