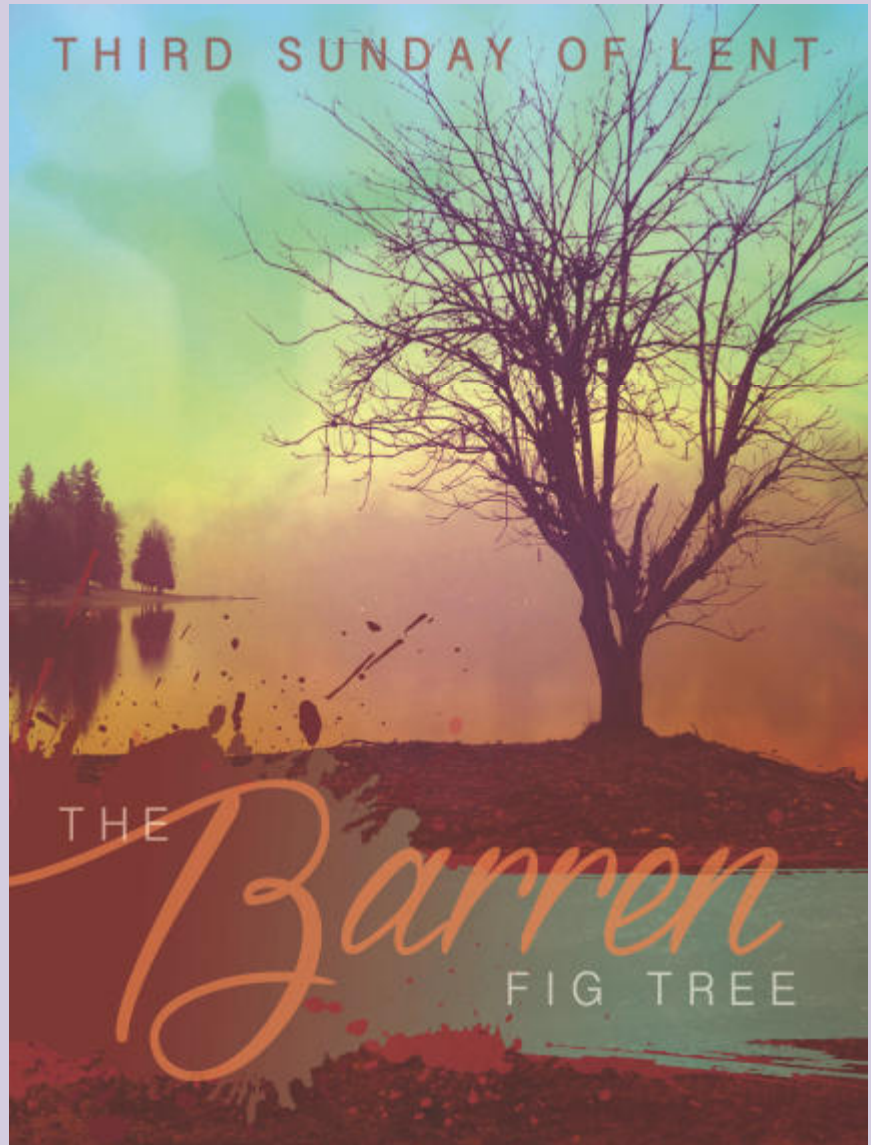

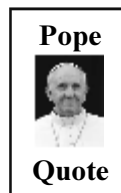

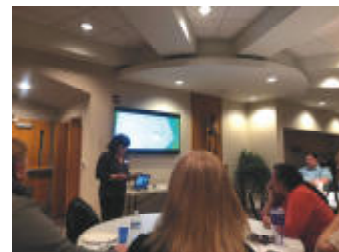


The Pastoral Council will meet on Wednesday March 27th in the Hospitality Room at 6:30 PM.. The agenda will include planning for the upcoming elections.
